# NEWS | Moldova

## Moldova Approves National Program for Full Customs Digitalization by 2030

The Moldovan government adopted a nationwide program to fully digitalize customs procedures and integrate national IT systems with EU customs platforms by 2030.

This is a key step toward EU interoperability and alignment with the EU Customs Data Model.

## Moldova is joining the EU Common Transit Convention (NCTS Implementation)

From 1 November 2025, Moldova is part of the EU Single Transit Network, implementing NCTS (P6). The customs service introduced new rules: e.g., automatic MRN assignment, stricter requirement to attach documents (like invoice / CMR), and fallback procedures in case of system downtime.

## Moldova. Digital Process Simplification Efforts

Moldova is advancing customs digitalisation by developing systems for automatic declaration processing and fully online applications for special regimes. As part of its EU integration path, Moldova is also exploring a national “single window” approach for customs and border formalities.

# NEWS | Georgia

## Georgia. Digital Customs Infrastructure & Risk Analytics

Georgia continues to enhance its customs digital infrastructure, particularly through the use of electronic systems that support risk-based customs control and streamlined procedures. For example, the country implements customs clearance zones (CCZ) that allow automatic registration of permits and electronic submission of documentation, facilitating trade and reducing manual procedures for businesses. These zones provide one-stop submission points for import, export, and transit documentation, enabling economic operators to benefit from fully electronic processing and faster clearance.

## Georgia advances strategic priorities for Eurasian transport and digital logistics

Georgia is positioning itself to strengthen connectivity and logistical performance by focusing on digitalisation of customs, investment in transport infrastructure, and expanded cross-border logistics cooperation with neighbouring countries. Strategic growth directions include enhancing multimodal transport, rail systems, and regulatory alignment with international standards.

## Ukraine. Strategic Digitalization Plan (2024–2026)

The Ministry of Finance of Ukraine approved a long-term digitalization plan for the State Customs Service through 2026. The plan includes cyber-security, paperless procedures, centralized IT systems, and a “single window” for trade.

## Ukraine. Harmonization with EU Customs Legislation

As of late 2025, Ukraine has implemented nearly **80 % of the provisions of the European Union Customs Code into its national legislation**, according to an official statement from the State Customs Service of Ukraine. This progress reflects ongoing efforts to bring Ukrainian customs rules closer to EU standards, supporting deeper regulatory alignment and facilitating cross-border trade procedures.

## Ukraine. New Digital Services Launched via Telegram Bot

**New features:** The State Customs Service of Ukraine launched new features in its Telegram bot: **AI-based consultations:** if a request isn't recognized, it's routed to an AI trained on customs law and practice, giving more precise, personalized responses.

**Voice input:** users (e.g., drivers, brokers) can ask questions by voice, making interaction faster and more accessible. Also, customs payment accounts were updated on the Single Window for International Trade portal.

## Armenia adopts Strategic Agenda with EU

In December 2025, the European Union and the Republic of Armenia adopted a new Strategic Agenda for deepening the EU–Armenia partnership, expanding cooperation in areas including connectivity, digital transformation, trade and transport links within the Eastern Partnership framework.

In September 2025, the EU and EBRD committed €45 million to support the construction of a centralized customs and logistics facility in Yerevan. The project aims to streamline cargo handling, reduce customs clearance time, and improve Armenia's trade logistics capacity.

Azerbaijan has initiated **digital customs modernization**, including auto-clearance systems for trusted traders, enhanced risk assessment tools, and expanded electronic guarantees, aimed at facilitating trade, growth and regional logistics leadership.

# CASE STUDY: IMPROVED BORDER FLOWS

EU Supports Better Transport Connections in Eastern Europe: Poland, Slovakia, Romania, Ukraine, and Moldova. The European Commission has signed grant agreements under the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) to fund key cross-border transport infrastructure projects across Poland, Slovakia, Romania, Ukraine, and Moldova.

This investment aims to strengthen regional connectivity, improve trade flows, and enhance integration with the EU transport network.

The funded projects include railway modernization, electrification, and standardization, as well as upgrades to ports and border crossings. Notably, in Ukraine and Moldova, these initiatives support the EU-Ukraine Solidarity Lanes, which ensure reliable transport corridors for goods during ongoing challenges and facilitate Ukraine's integration into the EU transport system.

# EU INTEGRATION & DIGITAL COMPLIANCE

In November 2025, the European Commission adopted the **2025 Enlargement Package**, providing a detailed assessment of reform progress in EU accession efforts for Ukraine, Moldova, and Georgia. The reports recognize Ukraine's consistent implementation of EU legislation, highlight Moldova's alignment efforts and commitment to EU integration, and outline recommendations for further reforms in Georgia's path toward EU integration. These evaluations serve as a roadmap for deepening legal, procedural, and digital harmonization with the EU.

Key trends across the region include:

- integration with the **New Computerised Transit System (NCTS)**
- development of **paperless customs workflows** and **single-window platforms**
- use of **automated risk management** and **data exchange systems**
- technical support from the EU to modernize customs infrastructure and accelerate trade

# Transport Community — New Technical Assistance & Opportunities

The **Transport Community Permanent Secretariat** has launched three EU-funded **technical assistance programmes** to support Ukraine and Moldova in aligning their transport sectors with EU standards. These initiatives are designed to improve regulatory frameworks, institutional capacity, and safety across road, maritime, and rail transport, and run through **spring 2026**. This assistance supports deeper integration with the EU transport market and creates opportunities for Ukrainian and Moldovan companies and institutions to engage in reform implementation and capacity building.

Key components of the new technical assistance include:

- **Road transport (Ukraine):** Drafting a package of **11 legal acts** aligned with EU type-approval requirements and a roadmap for reform implementation.
- **Maritime transport (Ukraine):** Preparing **13 EU-aligned maritime legal acts** and related implementation documentation.
- **Rail transport (Moldova):** Developing new regulatory acts, safety procedures, and institutional tools to support implementation of the EU rail acquis.

# Ukraine and EU Extend Road Transport Agreement - Practical Benefits for SMEs



Ukraine and the European Union have agreed to **extend the Road Transport Agreement**, continuing the liberalised regime for freight transport between Ukraine and EU member states. This agreement **removes the need for bilateral permits** for most cargo flows, which helps Ukrainian carriers and transport SMEs maintain stable access to EU markets and reduces administrative burdens. At borders, the extension contributes to **smoother logistics and fewer delays**, strengthening integration of Ukrainian transport operators into the EU freight network.

For logistics and transport companies, this means easier cross-border operations, lower permit-related costs, and more predictable planning for international routes — all critical for commercial competitiveness amid ongoing geopolitical and economic challenges.

## How the shift to EU standards will change the work of lorry drivers and what impact it will have

Ukraine's integration with the EU requires aligning lorry drivers' working-hour rules with EU social standards. While Ukraine follows AETR norms, enforcement is weak and lacks key EU Mobility Package requirements such as mandatory weekly rest outside the cabin, driver and vehicle return rules, and smart tachographs. Adopting and enforcing EU standards will reduce competitive disputes, improve road safety, and make logistics more predictable — strengthening Ukraine's chances for long-term access to the EU transport market.
