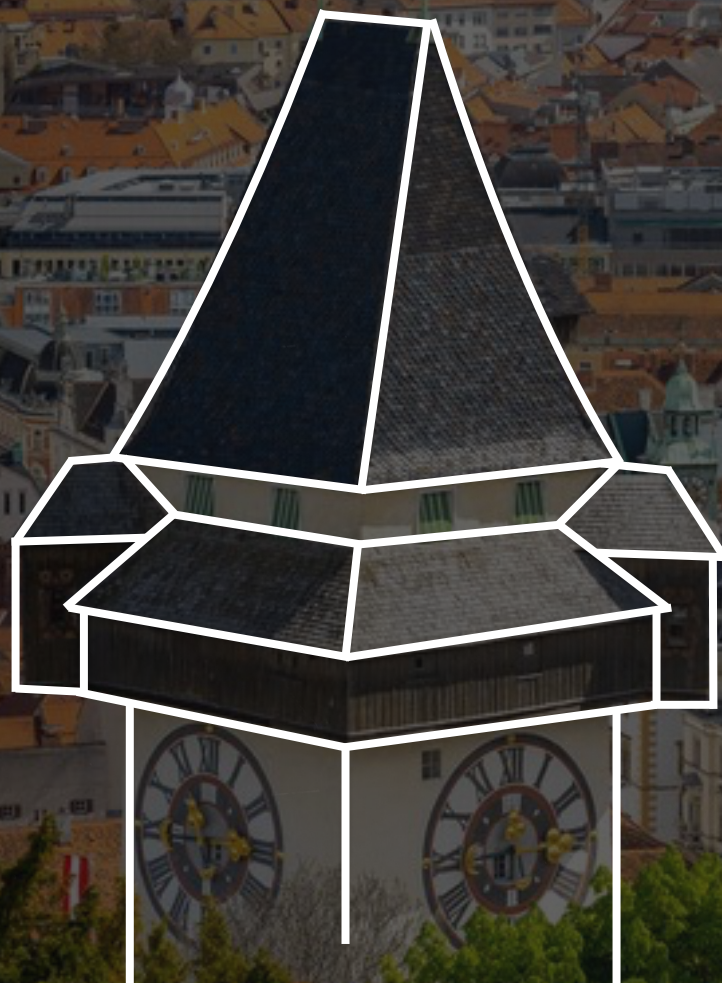

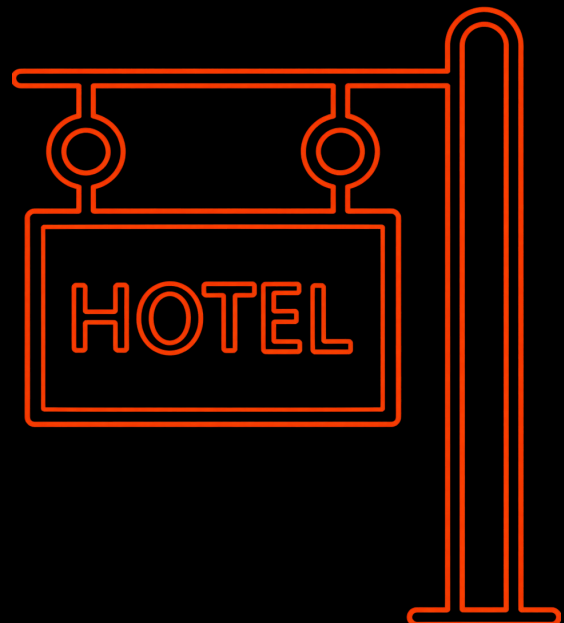

Busses in Graz provide convenient and sustainable access to almost everywhere. The dense public transport network makes it the ideal city for stress-free mobility without a car.



Just like busses, Grazes Trams provide convenient, sustainable and scenic transport. The Altstadt Bim facilitates free rides in the city center on certain lines.



For longer journeys, the S-Bahn provides a fast connection from A to B. For the traditional there is a line network plan of all public transport.



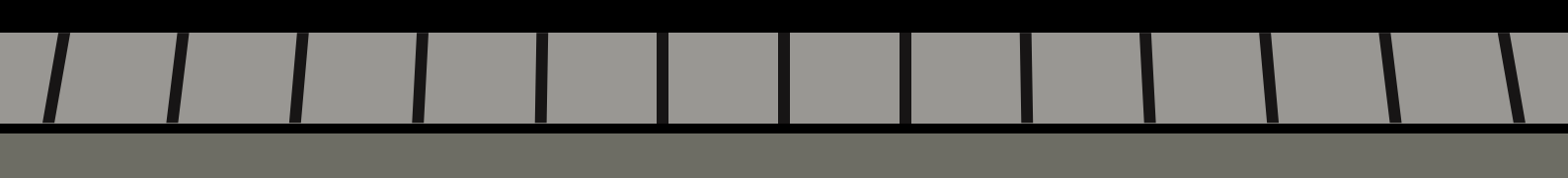
If you want to soak in every sight of the city or only have a short route ahead, you have the option to walk. The city is layed out well and very walkable.
