

PROFILE OF THE CIVIL PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY AGENCY OF CASTILLA Y LEÓN

The **Civil Protection and Emergencies Agency of Castilla y León** is the [management center of the Administration](#) of the Autonomous Community of Castilla y León that has powers over citizen protection.

The [actions of the Civil Protection and Emergency Agency of Castilla y León](#) are mainly regulated by Law 4/2007, of March 28, on citizen protection of Castilla y León.

Its powers include risk prevention and control, particularly self-protection; the planning of actions in emergencies with the coordination of all the intervening resources.

The Civil Protection and Emergency Agency [is organized into four departments](#):

- - The department that manages the European emergency number 1-1-2.
- - The department that manages the security provided in the municipalities through the local police.
- - The department that manages civil protection groups such as firefighters and civil protection volunteer associations.
- - The department in charge of training policemen, firefighters, civil protection volunteers...

[All the personnel](#) who work in the Civil Protection and Emergency Agency are [civil servants](#), with the exception of the workers who attend the European emergency telephone number 1-1-2, who are personnel with an employment contract.

Like all public administrations, the [Civil Protection and Emergency Agency must manage the recovery of normality after the catastrophe](#).

In order for the administrative management of the recovery of normality to be as fast as possible for the citizens, the intervening public administrations should have [an interconnected system that would allow them to interact with all the agents that were necessary to be able to adopt the most convenient decisions](#).

One of the key points of this recovery management system after the catastrophe is the [valuation/monetization of the catastrophe](#), of the damage caused by the catastrophe, for this reason, the Civil Protection and Emergency Agency of Castilla y León is interested to participate with a project that will develop this subject in the call [HORIZON-CL-3-2022-DRS-01-06 \(improved disaster risk pricing assessment\)](#).

The objective of the project is to obtain a tool that public administrations would use to find out as quickly as possible the economic consequences of a catastrophe and to be able to adopt the measures that are necessary so that people, companies and industries can recover as soon as possible the normal.

The development of the project: Identification of the affected territory - Identification of the people, companies, industries, institutions affected - Individualized identification of the damages suffered - Monetization of the damages (individual valuation of the damages) - Decision of the type of public intervention necessary to mitigate the damage.

The tool resulting from the project can be applied to [all types of catastrophe](#).

The Civil Protection and Emergencies Agency would like to have [the largest possible number of public entities that manage catastrophes as project partners](#) because it is a model that can be [easily transferred](#) to any administration.
