TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION EVENT (Short Version)

Organizer:

TASKA CZ s.r.o., Company ID No. 06288910, Jičínská 226/17, 130 00 Prague 3, registered with the Municipal Court in Prague, File No. C 279198, represented by Lucie Šarešová (hereinafter referred to as the “Organizer”).

1. Application and Contract Formation

Participation becomes valid upon delivery of a duly completed and signed Binding Application Form. The application is binding for the Exhibitor even without confirmation by the Organizer unless it is rejected within 5 working days.

Upon submission of the application, a contractual relationship between the Organizer and the Exhibitor is established.

2. Payment Terms

All payments (registration fee, rental fee, and services) are due according to the issued invoice.

Failure to pay shall be considered a material breach of contract — the Organizer is entitled to withdraw from the contract and demand a contractual penalty of 100% of the ordered services.

Cancellation of participation after submission of the application constitutes a full cancellation fee (100% of the rental and fees).

Non-participation does not entitle the Exhibitor to any refund or compensation.

3. Exhibition Area and Stand

The Organizer allocates exhibition space according to its possibilities and without obligation to meet the Exhibitor's preferences.

Failure to occupy the assigned area within the specified time allows the Organizer to freely dispose of it without refund.

Subletting or transferring any part of the area to third parties without the Organizer's written consent is prohibited.

4. Co-exhibitors and Contractors

Each co-exhibitor must be duly registered and approved.

An unregistered co-exhibitor is subject to a contractual penalty equal to the registration fee.

The Exhibitor is responsible for the conduct and actions of all subcontractors and contractors involved.

5. Complaints and Liability

Complaints regarding invoices must be made within 14 days of receipt.

Complaints about services can only be made during the event; no complaints are accepted after the event.

The Organizer is not liable for loss, damage, destruction, or theft of exhibits, equipment, or personal belongings — before, during, or after the event.

6. Changes and Event Cancellation

The Organizer reserves the right to change the date, location, or scope of the event without any right of the Exhibitor to compensation.

If the event is canceled, the Organizer will refund received payments after deducting preparation costs within 90 days.

7. Exhibitor's Obligations

The Exhibitor is obliged to:

- comply with the Organizer's instructions, technical and safety regulations, and event schedule,
- ensure booth cleaning and removal of exhibits after the event,
- use advertising and presentation materials exclusively within the allocated area,
- cover all damages caused by their activities or by their staff.

8. Sanctions and Retention Right

In case of non-compliance, the Organizer has the right to:

- charge a contractual penalty up to the amount of the ordered services,
- retain exhibits until all obligations are settled,
- exclude the Exhibitor from participation without any refund.

9. Final Provisions

By signing the application, the Exhibitor confirms that they have read, understood, and agree to these Terms and Conditions and are fully bound by them.

All legal relationships are governed by the laws of the Czech Republic. The competent court for any disputes is the court having jurisdiction over the Organizer's registered office.
