





Environment Park is the Technology Park in Torino that has been working on environmental innovation for over 20 years. They are a reference point for public administrations and companies that they support in their sustainability paths. It hosts Open Labs - about Green Chemistry & Circular economy, Hydrogen and surface engineering - and Demo site to test innovative energy and cleantech solutions.






















Social Impact: Acceleration, Skills. financing






