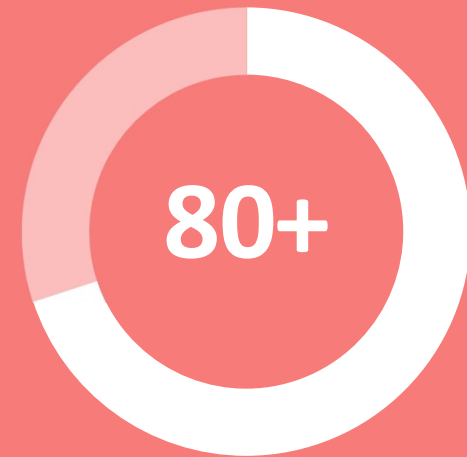

- 1 The public sector is recognized as one of the key pillars of the AI continent (hence the GenAI for PA call)
- 2 AI adoption in public administrations it in an early, exploratory phase
- 3 LRAs need a safe space to share challenges and learn from each other
- 4 Living-in.EU can be the basis for building a community of PAs on GenAI (CSA)
