








We inform on funding opportunities, flag different EU algae funded projects and initiatives and the latest studies and articles in our Knowledge library.












With this initiative we approach the EU algae sector in such a holistic way as never before"

Towards a strong and sustainable EU algae sector

European Parliament resolution of 11 May 2023 towards a strong and sustainable EU algae sector (2023/2547(RSP))



"The European Parliament,

- Agrees that there is untapped potential in this Sector
- Recognises the need for Member States to integrate algae cultivation into their national or regional spatial plans under the Directive for Maritime Spatial planning
- Calls for a more coherent regulatory framework for the sector, encouraging Member States to set up 'one-stop shops' for actors interested in starting or expanding algae farming operations
- Calls on the Commission to provide adequate funding for the EU algae sector, and on the Member States to continue encouraging the promotion of algae farming
- [...]


So, the Commission will continue to work hand in hand with the EU4Algae and other relevant stakeholders to let the EU Algae sector to thrive.




