## Philip Brey

Philip Brey is full professor of philosophy and ethics of technology at the department of philosophy, University of Twente, the Netherlands. He is also president of the International Society for Ethics and Information Technology (INSEIT). Brey's work focuses on the ethical and social implications of emerging technology, particularly information technology, robotics, biomedical technology and sustainable technology. He currently leads a European Union Horizon 2020 project, SIENNA (2017-2021, budget € 4.0 million), involving 13 international partners, on the ethical and human rights aspects of emerging technologies, in which one of the central goals is the development of ethical codes and ethics protocols for artificial intelligence and robotics. He is also a partner in the H2020 SHERPA project (2018-2021) which will develop ethical guidelines for smart big data: combinations of artificial intelligence and big data systems.
