Tom Van Teunenbroek received his doctorandus degree in Molecular Biochemistry/ Toxicology from Universiteit Utrecht in 1984. He then practised as a neurotoxicologist at the universities of Utrecht, Maastricht and Chicago, until in 1991 he became owner and co-founder of the environmental consultancy company Ameco. Then, from 2000- 05, van Teunenbroek took the position of State Supervisory Environmental Inspector for the Ministry of VROM (Environment). He has since been working at the Ministry of Infrastructure and Environment in a number of expert positions, including Policy coordinator, Research coordinator, Head of Delegation for The Netherlands for OECD-WPNM and Coordinator of the EU flagship project NANoREG and its follow-up Coordination Action ProSafe.

NANoREG was a collaboration of 16 countries, over 85 institutes, 380 man year of labour, 50 million euro project.
