Dr. Jürgen Lang is Director in the Innovation Management. His education started in 1979 in (micro)electronics and computer technology at Messerschmitt-Bölkow-Blohm. From 1982 on he worked as computer expert in industry, from 1986 till 2000 in different functions at Fraunhofer Institute for System Technology and Innovation Research (FhG-ISI at Karlsruhe). 1995 he finished his studies in high and highest frequency technology with the diploma degree from KIT - Karlsruhe Institute of Technology. 1998 he earned his doctorate in “Plasma Catalytic Effects of Barrierer Discharges” from KIT-Institute of Physical Electronics (Lightning Institute- LTI). In parallel he founded and headed between 1998 and 2000 the department of Plasma Technology of SME A. Lang GmbH. In 2000 he moved as Senior Scientist to Degussa-Hüls and joined the “New Processes Department”. Since 2004 he directed different R&D projects as well as investment projects. In 2010 he switched to the Innovation Management of Evonik Technology and Infrastructure GmbH’s BL “Process Technology & Engineering” as a Director.
