Co-founder and CTO at Saule Technologies. She is managing a team of 20 scientists from 11 countries working on the construction of the globally unique prototype production line for inkjet printed perovskite solar cells. She obtained her PhD from Institute of Molecular Science, University of Valencia where she developed novel perovskite cell architecture compatible with flexible foils. For this achievement, she was granted in 2014 with the Photonics21 Student Innovation award in a competition organised by the European Commission. Soon after, together with her business partners (Artur Kupczunas and Piotr Krych), she founded a start-up company Saule Technologies. For the successful implementation of ink-jet printing method to perovskite solar cells towards perovskite cell commercialization in 2015, she received MIT Technology Review's Innovator under 35.
