

DESCRIPTION OF A BALLAST CONSTRUCTION WITH HANDLES ON A FLAT ROOF




Fig.1 Dimension of K-34-1




Fig.2 Dimension of K-34-4

Keno sp.z o.o. provides a 10-year warranty on the above structure. The structure is assembled by loading the K-34-1 (Figure 1) and K-34-4 (Figure 2) mounting brackets. The technical department of Keno sp.z o.o., at the customer's request, can calculate the required minimum ballast. For this, specific investment information is needed (see table). The ballast structure can be used on roofs where the angle of inclination does not exceed 5° and the height of the building does not exceed $15 \, \mathrm{m}$

DATA FOR BALLAST CALCULATION
1. The exact location of the investment.
2. Roof dimensions + building height.
3. A Module dimensions + weight.
4. Visualization of modules distribution on the roof slope.
