The Kingdom of Granada was established in 1238 & was the richest & most opulent of all the Arabian Caliphates ever to be constructed in Spain. Adjoining the great Arabian Palace known as the Alhambra, which in itself was an architectural marvel, the Arabs having learned how to balance heavier masses on top of delicate columns, was the Menaralife. These exotic gardens contained species of flowering shrubs, trees & plants from all over the world.

They were a peaceful & harmonious haven for the Caliph's harem who spent their leisure hours strolling along the shaded paths amid cascading & bubbling fountains & quiet pools.

In 1492 Granada surrendered to the Catholic Monarchs Isabel & Ferdinand. Boabdil, son of the last Arabian King had been captured by the Xth for return for his freedom he proposed agreed to his father's lands. This important and ended Arabian domination of Spain.
