Wrist rotation

The Arabesque

Envuelto with arms over the head

Snake arms out at the sides and with backbend

The Gypsy Influence (first appearance in Egypt 5th century

Side to side head movements (oriental influence)
Backbend with T square snake arms out in front of the body
The Three Moods of Hand Clapping and finger snapping
Snake heads with hands alternating

15th century Gypsy Influences on Andalucian Dance

Shoulder movements

Zarandeo gypsy hip movements

Use of skirt to replace ancient fertility hip movements

Use of hands in the dance horns of the bull, spread fingers

The Flamenco Position (dates from B.C. Crete)
