

TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN / BRIEFING DATE	January 28, 2026 REGISTRATION REMINDER: All anglers must CHECK-IN in person with B.A.S.S. Staff onsite. This will be the only registration period. See Rule No. 4. You will be fined for being late.		
WEDNESDAY ACTIVITIES LOCATION	201 E. Dakin Ave. Kissimmee, FL 34741 (limited boat parking)		
OFFICIAL REGISTRATION / ON SITE CHECK-IN	10:00 am to 3:00 pm via Time slots. Onsite in person briefing and vessel electronic inspection will take place.		
TOURNAMENT BRIEFING	Mandatory in person immediately following check-in		
OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAYS	January 25-27. ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE OFF TOURNAMENT WATERS on Jan 28 . During official practice, competitors may only fish with other competitors per Rule 3ii.		
PRE -TOURNAMENT OFF-LIMITS	Off-limits will begin on Sunday December 28 th and extend through Sunday, January 25 @ safelight. During this time you are not allowed on tournament waters.		
TOURNAMENT WATERS	Tournament waters will be the Kissimmee Chain of Lakes and all rivers, canals and creeks connecting to the Kissimmee Chain of Lakes. Only water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. No locking South of HWY 60 (South end of Lake Kissimmee).

Balance deadline dates are the dates the balances are due. You will not receive any further notices on balance due. It is the anglers' responsibility to be sure payment is made by the deadline date.

Any balance of the entry fee paid in excess of the deposit will be refunded only if notification is made to the B.A.S.S. Tournament Department prior to the balance deadline date. Anglers on waiting list should not pay balance until contacted by tournament department.
