[Translated Version] Announcement of Thammasat University Regarding Admission of Non-Thai Citizens in Bachelor of Accounting (International Program) and Bachelor of Business Administration (International Program) BBA International Program Thammasat Business School, Thammasat University Academic Year 2024

As Thammasat University aims to develop, support and bring their education service to International level, and with the main course of action to accomplish said goal by accepting more full-time international students, the university has deemed it appropriate to accept more full-time Non-Thai students in Bachelor of Accounting (International Program) and Bachelor of Business Administration (International Program) under the Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration, International Program, Thammasat Business School, Thammasat University in Academic Year 2024. The University would like to announce its admission schedule and admission process as follows;

1. Class Location

The BBA International Program's class location will take place at Tha Prachan Campus. The University reserves all rights to change its class location if it sees appropriate and is approved by Thammasat University Council.

2. General and Specific Requirements

2.1 General Requirements

2.1.1 The applicant must possess a non-Thai citizenship and must not posess dual citizenship with eligibility to hold Thai passport. The applicant must be staying in Thailand legally with government-issued documents confirming their status.

2.1.2 The applicant must have graduated from High School level or equivalent, or studying in the last semester of high school. The applicant must have attained results and certification as dictated in Thammasat's Guideline for High School Certificate Equivalency of Thammasat University, 2564 B.E.

2.1.3 The applicant must not be enrolled in any other university or other higher-level education institutions, except for open-university and online education.

2.1.4 The applicant must has a clean bill of health, or at the very least, to the degree that will not severely obstruct their own education.

2.1.5 The applicant must not have committed any morally wrongdoings or have a behavior which would severely degrade themselves.

2.1.6 The applicant must not be those who have been punished as an agent or an accomplice of dishonest action in University Admission Process in the last 3 years.

2.2 Specific Requirements

The applicant must possess the following examination scores when they apply. Every application score must be sent to BBA International Program within the final day of application. 2.2.1 Examination score of Mathematics Proficiency (SAT: Scholastic Aptitude Test) or Gaokao score. The minimum score requirements are specified below:

All of the chosen score must come from the same examination, and the examination score will be valid only if taken only during January 2022 to March 2024. **Or**

2.2.2 Examination score of English Proficiency, one of the following: **TOEFL** or **IELTS**. The minimum score requirements are specified below:

The score chosen must not date back more than 2 years, counting from the last day in each round of application to the date which the examination is taken.

3. Number of Accepted Applicants

The BBA International Program will accepts international students in 2 separate rounds in 2 curriculums, with the total of 20 students. The details are as follow;

(1) The BBA program reserve all rights to not accept amount of applicants as specified above in the event that the applicants lack the required qualifications.

(2) In the event that number of accepted applicants in Non-Thai 1 does not reach the specified number above, the BBA program reserve all rights to increase the quota in Non-Thai 2 as the program sees fit.

4. Condition of Application

4.1 The applicant must certify and confirm that they met the requirements and possess qualifications as specified above. If later, the applicant is found to not have met any of the requirements or qualifications, the applicant will be considered void from the beginning. No refunds are made under any circumstances.

4.2 The applicant must read and understand the curriculum in details through www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th before applying online.

5. Application Selection Procedure

5.1 Examination score of Mathematics Proficiency and English Proficiency

The selection criteria consists of examination score of mathematics proficiency using SAT or Gaokao, and examination score of English proficiency using TOEFL or IETLS. The minimum score requirements and weights assigned are specified below: **Examination score of Mathematics Proficiency**

The Thammasat Business School Admissions Committee will determine the applicants who are eligible for the interview based on the ranking of their SAT or Gaokao score.

5.2 Interview and Essay Writing Examination

Interview and essay writing examination will be done in English by the interviewers appointed by the University. The minimum score requirement on the interview is as follows:

The judgment of the Thammasat Business School Admissions Committee is considered final.

The applicant eligible for interview must report to the BBA International Program in date time and venue as specified at www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th

5.3 Other Requirements

5.3.1 The applicant who is eligible for interview must follow each step as specified in later announcement, and participate in the interviewing process in date and time as specified. Failing to do so will result in disqualifying the applicants for the interview.

5.3.2 The selection of successful candidate will be determined by examination scores ranking with criteria as specified and the BBA International Program will accept numbers of students as specified above.

5.3.3 The applicants who are successful candidates must send in the complete valid transcript of high school and a graduation certificate. All documents must be submitted within the first day of the first semester in the academic year 2024. Failing to do so will result in removal of BBA Student Status.

5.3.4 The judgement of the Thammasat Business School Admissions Committee is considered final.

5.3.5 Applicant who have successfully applied will be regarded as if they have verified that they met all general and specific requirements. In the event that document is falsify or not as dictates by this announcement, their application will be voided and no refunds are made in any circumstances.

6. Admission Process

6.1 Apply and send in online documents through www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th.

6.2 Pay the application fee of Baht 1,500 or USD50 through the bank.

Application Submission Procedure

1. The applicant must complete application form and upload all required copies of important documents. The applicant must verify all copies by signing applicant's name. All must be done through www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th within the last day of application. The required documents are as follow:

(1) A photo with clear view of the applicant's face taken within 6 months prior to the application date. The head covering and sun glasses must not be worn in photos.

(2) Passport.

(3) High school transcript and certificate or documents from high school verifying graduating status.

(4) Examination score of Mathematics Proficiency and English Proficiency have to be sent in specifically through these methods:

1. SAT score report must be sent directly to the BBA International Program from the Education Testing Service. The code for BBA International Program is **0288** (Thammasat University)

2. Gaokao score report must be scanned into an electronic format as will be specify by the admission procedure. Then, it must be uploaded to BBA Online Application System.

3. TOEFL and IELTS scores must be sent directly to the BBA International Program from the examination institute. The code for BBA International Program are as follows:

TOEFL: 9384 (Thammasat University-BBA International Program) IELTS: 166886 (Thammasat University-BBA International Program)

The applicant must also upload their scanned copies of TOEFL and IELTS physical report. The score must match with the score that applicant fill in manually. This document must be uploaded to BBA's Online Application System.

Note that untruthful disclosure of applicant information results in voiding the student's application or dismissal from Thammasat University.

2. Once the applicant has completely filled out the online application form, the applicant must verify correctness and completeness of the information before printing out the application form and making payment for the application fee at the bank. If the information provided is incorrect or incomplete, please make necessary corrections. The University places importance only to the information provided in the on-line application system.

3. Payment application fee procedure are as follows;

(1) Applicant residing in Thailand

The applicant print their application form to make payment of Baht 1,500 via Teller Payment system to **Krung Thai Bank, PCL.** at any branch in Thailand, within the specified time.

(2) Applicant residing overseas

The applicant print out their application to make application fee of USD50 via money transfer to **Bangkok Bank, PCL.** (Thammasat University - Rangsit Campus Branch). Details of account are as follows:

The application fee must be paid during the specified time period. When the applicant has successfully paid the application fee, the applicant must send the evidence of payment in PDF file format to BBA International Program at bbaadmissions@tbs.tu.ac.th within the end of each application round. If the applicant does not send in said evidence, the application will be dismissed.

4. The applicant can check the payment status after 3 working days through www.bba.tbs.tu.ac.th. If applicant does not pay the fee in specified time, the application will be dismissed.
