Sunday Services

Entry to church services is strictly by pre-registration via Eventbrite and will be open to a maximum of 100 pax for fully vaccinated individuals.

Those who are not vaccinated but wish to register for service must obtain a negative Pre-Event Test (PET) result taken in the past 24 hours before the expected end of Sunday service.

All worshippers are to bring your mobile devices with the updated Trace Together app or your Trace Together token for verification purposes upon entry into the church premises.

Worshippers will be seated in separate zones holding no more than 100. There should be no intermingling of individuals across zones.

Masks are to be kept on at all times and there should be no intermingling between worshippers before, during or after each worship service.
