**Reflection Questions**

1. Read Luke 19:28-40 (and Mat 21:7-11; Mk 11:6-10; Jn 12:12-19). What are the expectations of the disciples and multitudes of Jesus (v.38)? What kind of "King" are they desiring? What kind of peace are they hoping for?

2. Notice that the Pharisee are *in* the crowd (v.39) with the disciples and multitude. Why? What is their attitude when they called Jesus "Teacher" even when the crowds called Him "King?" Why are they anxious to ask Jesus to "rebuke your disciples?"

3. Read the entire Chapter 19. Notice carefully who Jesus says He is or what is implied in the follow verses: 1) v.10; 2) v.12ff; 3) w.30-31; 4) v.40. There are four identity of Jesus in these verses.

4. Pause for a moment and mediate on these four identities/roles of Jesus. Which of these speak to you most? How will a fuller understanding of who Jesus is help you?
