### Announcements:

#### 1. Sunday Services

Entry to church services is strictly by pre-registration via Eventbrite and will be open from 19 Sept 2021 to a maximum of 100pax for fully vaccinated individuals. Those who are not vaccinated but wish to register for service must obtain a negative Pre-Event Test (PET) result taken in the past 24 hours before the expected end of Sunday service. All worshippers are to bring your mobile devices with the updated Trace Together app or your Trace Together token for verification purposes upon entry into the church premises.

Worshippers will be seated in separate zones holding no more than 50. There should be no intermingling of individuals across zones.

Masks are to be kept on at all times and there should be no intermingling between worshippers before, during or after each worship service. If you do receive a Health Risk Warning (HRW) or Health Risk Alert (HRA) notice, do follow MOH's guidelines for required testing and self isolate. Do also inform your small group leaders.

Reflection Questions (Ruth 2)

1. Ruth gleaned from Boaz's field (2:2ff). Read Leviticus 19:9-10 and Deuteronomy 24:19-21. Why did God institute this practice? What modern day equivalent of gleaning can we think of?
2. How is Boaz described in Ruth 2? Notice any description of his physical appearance (see 1Sam 16:7)? From his actions and words (e.g. v.4), list down some adjectives that makes Boaz "a worthy man" (v.1)? Did he expect anything in return from Ruth? How can Christians be like a "Boaz?"
3. Compare Naomi's response in 2:20 with 1:20-21. If God is unchanging, what could have caused Naomi's change in attitude? When things don't go our way, how should we respond?
