No meeting was held this month. Work done is mostly preparatory for the 2022 budget.

We got the necessary bids for wiring Willow Well House and have selected the best bid. Stingray Electric will be doing the work ASAP. We will still have to wait for inspection from Larimer County.

We tried connecting a generator to the system but so far have been unsuccessful due to plug mismatches. We are urgently looking for a proper adapter/cable. Lake Dissolved Oxygen levels are in the danger zone. We are now above 50/50 risk of losing a significant percentage of fish in Willow Lake.

We have successfully acquired a work boat with trailer and will acquire an electric trolling motor sufficient to power the boat to apply Lake Clarifier and Sludge/Muck treatments. We plan to see what other treatments we may be able to apply ourselves to save money. A big thank you to the board for allowing us to facilitate this purchase.

We still wish to improve cooperative efforts with Operations and Water Committees. This will help the efficiency of all aforementioned committees. There is still work to be done to facilitate better cooperation in the future.

A big issue that still needs to be addressed is getting access to the revenue generated by sales of Fishing Badges and Boat Stickers, both directly related to Lake Health and Fishing Committee budget.
