

Outdoor Fire Restrictions

1. Burning in incinerators is prohibited.
2. All fireworks, rockets, canons and other incendiary devices are prohibited.
3. Open fires within Big Elk Meadows are prohibited except for barbeque grills and patio fireplaces. No open fires are permitted off decks or patios.
4. Devices using gas, jellied petroleum, pressurized liquid fuel that do not have a shut-off switch is prohibited.
5. Charcoal grill should be on a flat noncombustible or fire resistive surface.
6. Wood may be used to enhance cooking in grills or smokers.
7. Outdoor wood fires are prohibited for short-term guests.
8. Outdoor wood fires are prohibited, except
 - a. In permanently constructed, stationary, masonry or metal fire pits specifically designed for the purpose of combustion, including a spark arrester.
 - b. In commercially constructed fire pits inclusive of a spark arrester.
9. Anytime a fire is held outdoors, the attendant must have a mechanism to extinguish the fire.
