Project Updates:

Willow Well House still needs one more vent located at the aeration pump level on the north side of Willow Wellhouse soon. We will need some trenching and drainage work done by Autumn on the west side (uphill) of the wellhouse to protect the integrity of the west wall.

• We continue efforts to work with Ops and Water Committee.

Meredith applied Water Clarifier treatments at Sept 11. All the lakes have been checked by Aquatic Assoc. Volunteers will began Muck treatments near all the weirs. Lake Clarifier treatments will continue. We have been very fortunate on the whole rains during the last or we would have bigger issues. Wel need to purchase at least two more rebuild kits. We are still waiting on the Grant to be funded for the Sunset Aeration System. The sooner this happens the better.

We are considering adding more Fathead Minnows to Willow and Rainbow as their population is lower percentage wise than the other lakes.

We have gotten through the rough part of summer in good shape. We will likely need another visit from Aquatics Asslc. in the next few weeks.
