Meetings: No meeting this month.. We need to set a date for a meeting for potential changes in policies, goal setting, and priorities to set a budget.

Project Updates:

Work order is being executed for repair of aeration pump on Mirror Lake.

Willow Well House still needs one more vent located at the aeration pump level on the north side of Willow Wellhouse soon.. We will need some trenching and drainage work done as soon as ground thaws on the west side (uphill) of the wellhouse to protect the integrity of the west wall. Inappropriate work order will be written at the proper time.

- We continue efforts to work with Ops and the Water Committee. Our efforts are bearing fruit and shall remain ongoing.
- Some electrical work will need to be done this spring for permanent power supply for Sunset Aeration System for which the Grant Money is in the works and should be received soon.
- There is the possibility of an additional \$5K. Grant for Algae Control. It is still way too early to make a prediction on the strategy for success of this Grant Funding. We will speak with Mallory Hiss on this subject soon as per her request.
