Expanding Lots in Larimer County – Pat, Kirk, Curt

On 10-23-23 we had a meeting with Larimer County to ask them a number of questions about expanding lots.

We have two members that are interested in expanding their lot onto BEM common land via the amended plat process. We confirmed with Larimer County this was possible. We had previously approved some basic ideas on a program for this for the Board. We are waiting for feedback from Legal and our tax advisors before we move forward make final recommendations.

Next Steps on Expanding Lots:



- Board to approved two appraisals from Dave Caddell for two potential expansions at a cost of \$1,250. Appraiser said he should have work done shortly. It has been difficult to find good comps but appraisal should come in any day 1/31/24.
- Board gets answers to questions on Lot expansion and other ideas from Legal and tax advisors

Community Facility Master Plan - Community Building/Maintenance Building/Caretakers Quarters Requirements and Potential Future Locations – Curt, Kirk, Cathy, Melinda, Bobby, Dan

We developed a draft template for a Community Facility Master Plan which included three potential new facilities, Maintenance building, Operations Manager's/Firefighter's Quarters and Community Center/Fire Training Facility. We looked at putting these facilities in some potential different locations. We determined that the cost for three different buildings that are all nice to have requirements would be a tough sell for our members. We discussed the possibility of putting all or some of the functionality required in an addition to the Fire Station which has benefits in that funding for this would be voluntary and through donations.

Bobby is a member of the LTPC and VFD of BEM Board. He has asked Curt to present to the Fire Dept Board, to see if there is interest on Wed Feb 21. If yes, we can bring these ideas to the BEM Board for their Input.

Forest Service Permit – Pat, Curt
