Heritage exhibits will be open to the public during building hours each day of the Fair.

RULES

1. Iowa Family Living general rules and regulations apply in this department. In case general rules conflict with Heritage Department general or special rules, the latter shall govern.
2. **SUBMITTING ENTRIES.** Entries may be made online at www.iowastatefaireentry.org. Entries may also be made by printing the Iowa Family Living form available at www.iowastatefair.org. Complete entry form and return it with **full payment** of all fees to: Iowa State Fair, Iowa Family Living Department, P.O. Box 57130, Des Moines, Iowa 50317-0003.
3. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1.** Entries must be submitted online or postmarked on or before July 1.
4. **ENTRY FEE.** Each exhibitor in this department, as a requirement for entry, will pay an entry fee. Tags will be issued based on the number listed on the entry form. No additional tags will be issued after July 8. Please list the EXACT number of tags you would like to receive.

Entry fee in the Limited Division is \$8 (limit 1 entry).
5. **LATE ENTRIES.** Double entry fees will be charged for all entries submitted online or postmarked July 2 - July 8. No entries will be accepted after July 8.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

6. Entries in this department are limited to living residents of Iowa.
7. Exhibitors are limited to one entry in each class. Exhibitors are limited to one class in Large Item Collections, Division 715.
8. No articles will be accepted after being shown two consecutive years. Articles cannot be shown both in individual classes and collections.
9. Exhibits or artifacts are to be genuine articles at least 50 years old. Judges will consider authenticity and condition of exhibits. **Reproductions are not acceptable entries.**

ENTRY TAGS

10. Entry tags will be mailed to you to be completed and placed on articles by you before delivery. No untagged articles will be accepted. A completed Entry List of all items brought must accompany articles.

DELIVERY OF ENTRIES

11. Articles are to be delivered to Pioneer Hall on Sunday, August 8 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. or Monday, August 9 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
12. Articles entered may be sent by mail. For standard mail, send to: Iowa State Fair, Heritage Department, P.O. Box 57130, Des Moines, IA 50317. For UPS or FedEx, send to: Iowa State Fair, Heritage Department, 3000 East Grand Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50317. Articles must be received by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, August 6. In no case will packages be received and articles placed on exhibition unless all charges are prepaid.

JUDGING

13. Judges decisions are final. In classes with limited entries, the judges will make the placing according to the quality of the articles.
14. A Sweepstakes rosette will be awarded in Divisions 700-714.

RECLAIMING ENTRIES

15. **NO ARTICLES WILL BE RELEASED FROM THIS DEPARTMENT UNTIL MONDAY, AUGUST 23.** Articles may be picked up Monday, August 23 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in Pioneer Hall. Articles will be returned by mail or UPS providing postage is furnished to the Superintendent.
16. Beginning Wednesday, August 25 and until Friday, September 3, articles can be picked up in the Administration Building. Hours are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. weekdays and 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 28 and Sunday, August 29. (Please note: Entries will not be available for pick up on Tuesday, August 24.) **After September 3 all unclaimed items become the property of the Iowa State Fair and will be disposed of as deemed necessary.**

LIABILITY

17. The Management will use diligence in caring for the safety of entries after their arrival and placement, but in no case will they be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.

Limited Division - Entry Fee \$8

First three entries in each class will be accepted.

Premiums in Division 715\$80, 60, 40

RULES

1. Open to museums, historical societies, communities or individuals. A collection consists of not less than 10 items pertaining to one of the four classes. This could be a typical room in a house, farming equipment, barbershop, cobbler shop or a general display of articles of the period.
2. Each exhibitor may enter one class. Exhibitor must list class on entry form. Same articles may not be entered over two years. This division is limited to one per family.
3. These exhibits will have a maximum space allowed of 4 x 8 feet and arranged by exhibitor with the approval of the Superintendent. Describe items in exhibit and number.
4. A plaque will be given for the first prize winner in each class and a rosette will be awarded for the next two places in each class.
