

THE ACCOUNTS OF THE EYE-WITNESSES

The first four books of the New Testament are accounts of the life of Jesus. Matthew, an apostle, wrote sometime before the destruction of Jerusalem, A.D. 70. (Jesus was crucified in A.D. 30). Mark, a disciple (not an apostle) of Jesus and companion to Barnabas, Paul and Peter, probably wrote earlier -- very likely before A.D. 50. Luke, most likely a Gentile, was a companion to Paul. His gospel was written before Acts -- about A.D. 60. John, an apostle, lived to an old age and may have written his account as late as 96-98 A.D.

Lack of space means we cannot reproduce all these accounts of the crucifixion and resurrection. We are giving the chapter and verse references so that you can read them in your Bible, and we are printing Matthew's account below:

Matthew 27:33-28:7 (New American Standard Version)

33 And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, which means Place of a

34 they gave Him wine to drink mingled with gall; and after tasting it. He was unwilling

35 And when they had crucified Him, they divided up His garments among themselves, casting lots:

36 and sitting down, they began to keep

watch over Him there.

37 And they put up above His head the charge against Him which read, "THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS."

38 At that time two robbers *were crucified with Him, one on the right and one on the

39 And those passing by were hurling

abuse at Him, wagging their heads,

40 and saying, "You who are going to destroy the temple and rebuild it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross."

41 In the same way the chief priests also, along with the scribes and elders, were mock-

ing *Him*, and saying,

42 "He saved others; He cannot save Himself. He is the King of Israel; let Him now come down from the cross, and we shall believe in Him.

43 "HE TRUSTS IN GOD; LET HIM DELIVER Him now, IF HE TAKES PLEASURE IN HIM; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.'"

44 And the robbers also who had been crucified with Him were casting the same in-

sult at Him.

45 Now from the 46 sixth hour darkness fell upon all the land until the 47 ninth hour.

46 And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "ELI, ELI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" that is, "My God, My God, WHY HAST THOU FORSAKEN ME?

47 And some of those who were standing there, when they heard it, began saying, "This

man is calling for Elijah.

48 And immediately one of them ran, and taking a sponge, he filled it with sour wine, and put it on a reed, and gave Him a drink.

49 But the rest of them said, "Let us see whether Elijah will come to save Him."48

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud

voice, and yielded up His spirit.

51 And behold, the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom, and the earth shook; and the rocks were split.

52 and the tombs were opened; and many bodies of the saints who had fallen asleep were

raised:

53 and coming out of the tombs after His resurrection they entered the hole sity and appeared to many.

54 Now the centurion, and those who were with him keeping guard over Jesus, when they saw the earthquake and the things that were happening, became very frightened and said, "Truly this was the Son of God!"

55 And many women were there looking on from a distance, who had followed Jesus

from Galilee, ministering to Him,

56 among whom was Mary Magdalene, along with Mary the mother of James and Joseph, and the mother of the sons of Zebedee.

- 57 And when it was evening, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus.
- 58 This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate ordered it to be given over to him.

59 And Joseph took the body and

wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,

- 60 and laid it in his own new tomb, which he had hewn out in the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the entrance of the tomb and went away.
- 61 And Mary Magdalene was there, and the other Mary, sitting opposite the grave.
- 62 Now on the next day, which is the one after the preparation, the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered together with Pilate,
- 63 and said, "Sir, we remember that when He was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I am to rise again.

64 "Therefore, give orders for the grave to be made secure until the third day, lest the disciples come and steal Him away and say to the people, 'He has risen from the dead,' and the last deception will be worse than the first."
65 Pilate said to them, "You have a guard;

go, make it as secure as you know how.

66 And they went and made the grave secure, and along with the guard they set a seal on the stone.

28 Now after the Sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to look at the grave.

2 And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the

stone and sat upon it.

3 And his appearance was like lightning,

and his garment as white as snow;

4 and the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.

5 And the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid; for I know that you are looking for Jesus who has been crucified. 6 "He is not here, for He has risen, just as

He said. Come, see the place where He was

lying.
7 "And go quickly and tell His disciples He is going before you into Galilee, there you will see Him; behold, I have told you.


THE OTHER GOSPEL ACCOUNTS of the crucifixion and resurrection are:

Mark 15:22-16:7 Luke 23:32-24:9 John 19:17-20:18

Read these accounts carefully. Note how calmly and carefully the facts are told. Note the apparent discrepancies, just as there are apparent discrepancies in the stories of independent witnesses to any event. But also note that these discrepancies are not real. All the stories harmonize when examined closely.

Remember, three of these writers were there, and Luke had opportunity to interview many who were there, including Mary the mother of Jesus. These accounts cannot be lightly dismissed!

HOW WE GOT THE BIBLE



The New Testament manuscripts we have today are authentic. Manuscripts of the entire New Testament date from 350 A.D. Writings of early Christians before A.D. 150 contain quotes from these books. Some versions (translations) survive which date to 150 A.D. What we have today are not corruptions, but authentic copies of the originals.
