- At least two festivals from Section B

If your film has been accepted to two or more Section B festivals only, at least one of those qualifying festivals must have been within this year's eligibility period of 1 November 2023 - 30 November 2024

To be eligible for BIFA 2024, short films must have been completed after I May 2023
