9		NEW STAR (IRE)	Gerald Mosse	Rider explained that he was asked to ride the gelding from a wide barrier conservatively in the early stages. He said accordingly he shifted NEW STAR behind runners shortly after the start and his mount travelled satisfactorily until approaching the 500m. He said




