He said that throughout the race he encouraged FAROOH AL SHAHANIA to race competitively, however the colt did not respond and finished distanced. Alberto Sanna said he conveyed his post- race comments to connections although he was unaware if the trainer was present at this time. In the circumstances Stewards did not hold any integrity concerns regarding Alberto Sanna's tactics, however he was reminded of his obligations to provide appropriate post-race feedback to the trainer. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

Apprentice Samuel Legrix (ZIDANE) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under Rule 58 (iv), in that near 250m he permitted his mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of MARKESE PY, which lost its rightful running and was hampered. Apprentice Samuel Legrix was suspended from riding in races for two Qatar race meetings to be conducted on 15 th and 16 th February 2024.
