Passing the 1300m after improving quickly, was checked after racing onto the heels of SHUK ZAKHIR, which after initially being clear to shift in, then shifted in when barely clear. As the Stewards determined that MINSK improving during the relevant stages had contributed significantly to the incident, no action was taken other than reminding Apprentice Saleh Faraj Al-Otaibi he is to be alert where runners are positioned relative to his mounts, and Apprentice Arnaud De Lepine was advised to exercise care when improving in similar circumstances. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities

A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

He said while continuing using the whip in the right hand his mount shifted out further whilst hanging out. He said as he is well acquainted with the colt he was reluctant to change the whip to his left hand, as previously AL KAZIM hung in, and in the circumstances he believed it was preferable to maintain its momentum and continue using the whip in his right hand, albeit it shifted out considerably in the straight, thereby compromising his finishing position (placed third). Jefferson Smith conceded that in retrospect he should have changed the whip to his left hand, in an endeavor to prevent AL KAZIM from continually shifting.

				Passing the 1000m was steadied when momentarily tightened by SOLAR ACLAIM (App Arnaud De Lepine), which shifted in marginally. LOOSE CANNON, which was following, was steadied as a consequence. Apprentice Arnaud De Lepine was severely reprimanded and advised to exercise far greater care in future. Became awkwardly placed on the heels of LIGHTNING LEO near the 300m, was steadied and shifted out, as LIGHTNING LEO which was laying in, shifted in. Rider explained that he was given the option to lead in the pace was genuine or alternatively to settle prominently with cover if other riders showed intent to lead. He said that in the early stages after beginning well he noted that LIGHTNING LEO was improving quickly to his outside and therefore surrendered the lead near the 1200m to obtain with cover.
