

Race 1: THOROUGHBRED MAIDEN PLATE (Class 6) (Far Bend) 1500m

General:

As Apprentice Rashid Ali Al-Marri* (-1.5kg) failed to arrive on course by the prescribed time, permission was granted for Apprentice Samuel Legrix to ride SALAH AL DEEN (IRE). Rashid Ali Al-Marri* (-1.5kg) was fined Qr1000.

1		BAGGY POINT (IRE)	Mohammed Tabti* (-2.5kg)	Carried in by another runner at the start. Near the 800m was eased to avoid the heels DREADFORT (Saleh Faraj Al-Otaibi), which shifted in when not clear. Saleh Faraj Al-Otaibi was reprimanded.
2		BAILEY GATE (IRE)	Alberto Sanna	Rider reported that his mount, which was racing keenly through the early and middle stages, hung out for the majority of the race and due to its racing manners in the straight BAILEY GATE proved difficult to be placed under pressure and consequently he was unable to properly test the colt over the final 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.
3		DAWN VEGA (GB)	Louis Nomis* (-4kg)	Checked near the 1300m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.
4		DREADFORT (GB)	Saleh Faraj Al-Otaibi* (-4kg)	At the start shifted in abruptly despite the effort of its rider. Tightened near the 1300m.

				Near the 900m was momentarily crowded and became unbalanced between MOUNT DUKONO and DAWN VEGA both of which shifted slightly.
5		GOLD GUY (IRE)	Stephane Ladjadj	From a wide barrier shifted behind runners in the early stages. Bumped at the start.
6		LIABLE (GB)	Soufiane Saadi	Giuseppe Cultraro (ZILAL) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under Rule 58 (iv), in that near the 1300m he directed his mount to the outside of BAILEY GATE when insufficiently clear of LIABLE, initially crowding that colt onto MOUNT DUKONO, which became unbalanced, and ultimately resulting in LIABLE having to be checked. When LIABLE was checked it shifted out crowding MOUNT DUKONO, onto HARRIER MAN, which became unbalanced tightening DREADFORT, which was carried outwards causing DAWN VEGA to be checked. Giuseppe Cultraro was suspended from riding in races for two Qatar race meeting to be conducted on the 13 th and 14 th March 2024. Shifted in and brushed the running rail near the 600m.
7		PHERENIKOS (IRE)	Szczepan Mazur	Commenced only fairly then lost ground when crowded by ZILAL, which shifted out slightly.

Apprentice Louis Nomis was suspended from riding in races for one Qatar race meeting to be conducted on the 7 th of March 2024 and was fined Qr 2500 in lieu of one additional race meeting. Eased to avoid the heels of GOLD GUY, which shifted in marginally near the 1200m.

After taking evidence from Mirko Sanna and Trainer Deborah Amanda Clare Mountain the matter was adjourned to a day to be fixed.</p> <p>Stewards continued the inquiry on 5/3/24.</p> <p>Mirko Sanna (IT'S A HOT ONE) was found guilty to a charge of failing to ride to the satisfaction of the Racing Stewards under Rule 58 (vii).</p> <p>The particulars being that after being positioned at the rear of the field entering the straight, he failed to ride his mount, which was closing off well, with sufficient vigour and purpose during the final 400m.</p> <p>Mirko Sanna was suspended from riding in races for two Qatar race meetings to be conducted on the 13th & 14th of March 2024.</p>



He said that after beginning well he immediately eased the colt and allowed runners to cross him, whereby he ultimately settled towards the rear of the field. He said that early in the straight, he immediately placed HANDSOME CHAP under pressure and although the colt responded well, it was reluctant to shift to the outside of HEATER for some distance after the 200m. He said that after securing a clear run after the 300m, HANDSOME CHAP closed off strongly . Tomas Lukasek conceded that in retrospect he erred by not attempting to maintain a prominent position, however having regard to his instructions was reluctant to pressure the colt during the relevant stages. Stewards advised him that whilst the error of judgment, by allowing his mount to settle at the rear of the field was not culpable, he would be expected to display more initiative by adapting to circumstances of the race, irrespective of his instructions.


