6		<b>ARMAN (QA)</b>	Soufiane Saadi	<p>Commenced to race fiercely for some distance after the 1800m and made the turn awkwardly leaving the straight on the first occasion, got its head on the side and proved reluctant to settle.</p> <p>When questioned rider explained that he has been asked to ride the colt prominently in possible. He said that leaving the straight on first occasion his mount raced fiercely and as he anticipated NA'NAAH to lead, he was comfortable to trail that runner. He said however, when NA'NAAH did not maintain the lead and several runners improved from the 1200m to either lead or race prominently, he was ultimately relegated to a midfield position due to being unable to shift out and improve as runners were positioned directly outside him. He said the circumstances of the race particularly with the colts' inexperience, resulted in ARMAN settling further back than intended.</p> <p>Mohammed Moussa (NA'NAAH) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under Rule 58 (iv), in that near the 1500m he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of ARMAN which was checked and clipped the heels NA'NAAH.</p> <p>Mohammed Moussa was suspended from riding in races for two Qatar race meeting to be conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024.</p>
