Trainer Abdulrahman Abdulwahed engaged Giuseppe Cultraro to ride A A CRAFTED SAND without obtaining his prior agreement. Mr Abdulrahman Abdulwahed was fined QR 1,000 under the provisions of Rule 35B.

2		BATAK (FR)	Louis Nomis* (-4kg)	Near the 700m became unbalanced after being bumped by MJ LATTAM TWO, which made the turn awkwardly and shifted out. At approximately the 1150m was crowded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

However, Apprentice Abdulla Rashid Al-Hajri was reprimanded and advised to avoid contributing to similar incidents by attempting to prevent his mounts from shifting when not clear of other runners. Near the 700m made the turn awkwardly and shifted out. Apprentice Mohammed Hassan Ali Alabdulmalik (KEHEILAN AL SAKAB) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under Rule 58 (iv), in that at approximately the 1150m he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of BATAK, which was crowded onto TEXAS STORM CS, which was badly hampered, resulting in MJ LATTAM TWO being steadied across the heels of JUBRAN. Apprentice Mohammed Hassan Ali Alabdulmalik was suspended from riding in races for one Qatar race meeting to be conducted on 4 <sup>th</sup> April 2024.

2		<b>GOLDINGGREATSTORE (IRE)</b>	Faleh Bughanaim	Raced wide and without cover for the majority of the event.
3		<b>HACKMAN (IRE)</b>	Ivan Rossi	Raced wide and without cover for the majority of the event. Close to the finishing line could not be tested when awkwardly placed on the heels of GOLDINGGREATSTORE.
4		<b>HEATER (IRE)</b>	Anas Al Seyabi	When questioned rider explained that he had been asked to ride the colt prominently if possible and it was anticipated this would be in about 3 <sup>rd</sup> of 4 <sup>th</sup> position. He said from a wide barrier HEATER commenced well and he endeavoured to obtain cover, however when he observed several runners to his inside maintain their position, he was reluctant to pressure the colt as this would result in HEATER having to obtain the lead, consequently he raced wide and without cover throughout. He further explained that over the concluding stages, the colt made an abnormal respiratory noise and he desisted from pressuring it during the final 30m. Anas Al Seyabi was advised in the circumstances of tonight's race he should have improved during the relevant stages to offset racing wide and where possible avoid covering unnecessary ground. Anas Al Seyabi was fined Qr 500 (Rule 61) for failing to report to the Stewards the colts' respiratory issue following the race. As HEATER had been removed from the post-race holding area within the prescribed time, Stewards directed Trainer Mr Gassim Ghazali to present HEATER to the Veterinary Clinic for an examination which includes the results of an endoscope tomorrow morning. The results will then be considered by the Head of Veterinary Regulation prior to HEATER being permitted to be declared next.



Rider explained that his mount was unsuited by the 1700m on tonight's surface, he said that although the gelding had performed well over a similar distance on turf it did not cope with the conditions of tonight's race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.
