He said that in the early stages he was racing wide and without cover outside MOUNT DUKONO and when that runner settled off pace, he elected to improve and settle upsides the leader NOO POINT near the 1200m. He said that when the rider of NOO POINT maintained his position, it resulted in NOO POINT and TIMBUKTOO travelling in a fast tempo from the 900m, as he continually pressured TIMBUKTOO to maintain its position. He conceded that he had ridden an ill-judged race from the 900m until approaching the home turn, acknowledging that his tactics had been detrimental to his mount and NOO POINT. Stewards advised him that in similar circumstances it would be advantageous to allow his mount to settle slightly behind NOO POINT, so as to afford both runners every opportunity to finish their races off as best as they are able. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.
