Here we have simplified the notice so that you can clearly understand how your scores were calculated and you can adjust your strategy for the next attempt.

Process for Arriving at Final Score in IBPS PO Mains Exam 2015

These steps were applied in arriving at your final overall score. You can cross-check your score here.

1. Get number of questions answered correctly by you. (Total Correct Questions)
2. Calculate total marks using these correct questions. (Total Marks)
3. Get number of questions answered incorrectly by you. (Total Incorrect Questions)
4. Calculate final marks by deducting the negative marks. (Final Marks)
5. Normalize scores of all the slots to make them equivalent for all the students. (Equated Scores)
6. Final marks are rounded off to two digits after the decimal point. (Final Score)

IBPS PO Mains Cut Off 2015

After final marks in each section and total marks are calculated. Cutoffs are applied at 2 stages.

1. On scores in individual test (section).
2. On total score.

You need to clear all the individual cutoffs marks and total cutoff marks for selection.

Here are the overall cutoff marks for total score:

Scheduled Caste (SC)	50.00
Scheduled Tribe (ST)	47.75
Other Backward Classes (OBC)	76.00
General (GEN)	76.00
Hearing Impaired (HI)	35.25
Orthopedically Challenged (OC)	52.50
Visually Impaired (VI)	36.00

CWE Online Main Examination for Recruitment of Probationary Officers/ Management Trainees (CWE-PO/MT-V – Main) in Participating Organisations

I. Process for Arriving at Scores

The Scores of Online Main Examination are obtained by adopting the following procedure:

- (i) Number of questions answered correctly by a candidate in each objective test is considered for arriving at the Corrected Score after applying penalty for wrong answers.
 - (ii) The Corrected Scores so obtained by a candidate are made equivalent to take care of the minor difference in difficulty level, if any, in each of the objective tests held in different sessions to arrive at the Equated Scores*.
- * Scores obtained by candidates on any test are equated to the base form by considering the distribution of scores of all the forms.
- (iii) Final scores in each test are rounded off to two digits after the decimal point.

Note: Cutoffs were applied in two stages:

- (i) on scores in individual tests
- (ii) on Total Score

The details of the cutoffs applied on Scores, of online examination, in individual tests and on Total Score is given below at (II) and (III) respectively.
