SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria

With the release of the SBI PO Application form, the race for getting one of the 2200 vacancies on offer for the post of Probationary Officer is set to begin. As a result of this, various queries regarding SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria will start to surface. Potential aspirants would want to confirm whether they fit into the various eligibility norms set by the SBI. The candidates found of not following the eligibility criteria would not be allowed to take the examination and would be robbed off their candidature.

Details for the SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria

1. Age Criteria for SBI PO 2016

According to the SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria, the candidate must be aged between **21 years** to **30 years** of age as on **1st April 2016**. In other words, only those candidates whose birthdates fall between 2nd April 1986 and 1st April 1995 (both dates inclusive) would be eligible to apply. However, the upper age of the candidates has been relaxed depending upon the category from which they come from. The relaxations are as follows:

Category	Age Relaxation
Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe	5 Years
Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy layer)	3 Years

Persons with Disabilities (PWD)	PWD (SC/ST) – 15 Years PWD (OBC) – 13 Years PWD (Gen) – 10 Years

Note: Cumulative age relaxation is not available either under the above items or in combination with any other items.

2. Educational Qualification Criteria for SBI PO 2016

Here are the academic requirements as per SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria

- Graduation in any discipline from a recognized University or any equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Central Government.

- Final Year/Semester students can also apply provided they produce proof of having passed the graduation examination on or before 31st August 2016.

- Candidates pursuing Integrated Dual Degree should ensure that the date of passing is on or before 31st August 2016.

- Candidates possessing qualification of Chartered Accountant (CA) may also apply.

3. Conduct

Candidates against whom there are adverse reports regarding conduct are not eligible to apply for the post. These adverse reports of conduct are those that are considered contrary to community standards of justice, honesty or good morals.











4. Credit Score

According to SBI PO 2016 Eligibility Criteria, candidates with record of default in repayment of loans/credit card dues and/or against whose name adverse report of CIBIL or other external agencies are available are not eligible to apply for the post.
