Accede (*verb*)

Hindi translation: **मान लेना**

Meaning: Agree

Pronounced: A-seed

Memory Tip: **After long demands, my mother finally acceded and bought me a seed of the expensive rose flower I wanted.**

Use in Sentence: Even though he needed money, Harry did not accede to the bank's loan agreement.



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Suite (noun)

Hindi translation: कमरों का सेट

Meaning: A set of rooms in a hotel, designed for a family's use.

Pronounced: Sweet

Memory Tip: **The hotel offered complimentary sweets to the suite guests.**



Use in Sentence: She occupied the largest suite on the topmost floor of the building.

Rancid (adjective)

Hindi translation: खट्टा और बासी

Meaning: Unpleasant taste or smell of decomposed or rotten food.

Memory Tip: **Ran + Cid → Ran + Sid → Sid ran towards the washroom as his stomach was upset from eating rancid food.**

Use in Sentence: The peanuts had gone rancid sitting outside in the open air.

Abyss (*noun*)

Hindi Translation: **अगाध गर्त**

Meaning: A bottomless or very deep pit.

Memory Tip: A + byss → Ek + Bees → एक + बीस → यह एक बीस फीट का गहरा कुंड (abyss) है



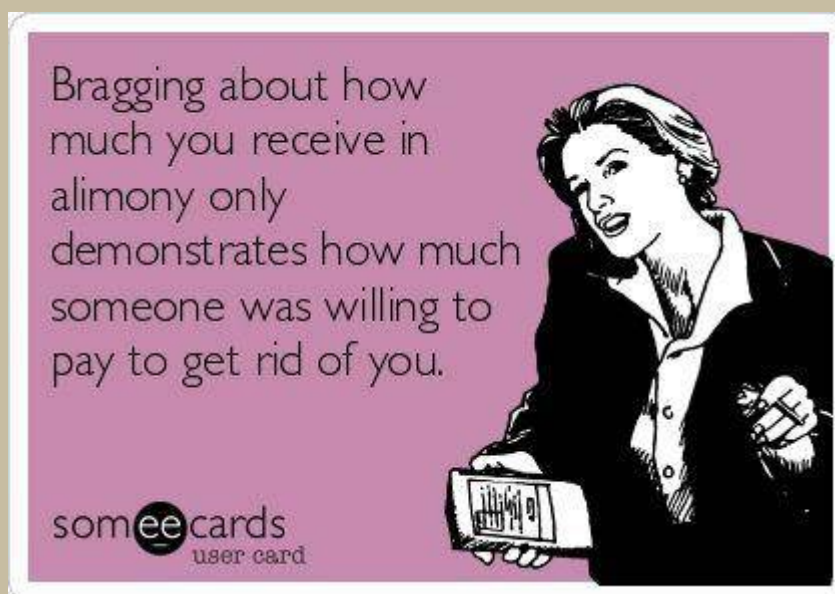
Use in Sentence: They discovered a new species of blind sharks that live in the ocean abyss.

Alimony (*noun*)

Hindi translation: *निर्वाह निधि*

Meaning: Payments made regularly to an ex-wife/ex-husband after divorce

Memory Tip: **Al + I + Mony** → **All + I + Money** → **I lost all my money in the divorce on alimony to my wife.**



Use in Sentence: His ex-wife asked for basic alimony and the house in the divorce.
