



RBI Recruitment 2016 Notification - Grade B Officers (General)

The **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI) has released its notification for recruitment of **163 Officers in Grade 'B' (General)** through Direct Recruitment. An additional 11 posts have been announced for Officer in Grade 'B' in DEPR and 8 posts for Officer in Grade 'B' at DSIM. #3. Eligibility Criteria for RBI Recruitment 2016 of Grade 'B' Officer

A. Citizenship:

Only Indian citizens, citizens of Nepal and subjects of Bhutan, persons of Indian origin who have migrated from Myanmar & Sri Lanka with the intention of permanently settling in India, are eligible to apply.

B. Age Limit:

As on 1st July 2016, candidates must meet the following age limits for RBI Recruitment 2016.

Minimum Age Limit: 21 years. Maximum Age Limit: 30 years.

C. Relaxations in Upper Age Limit:

- 1. OBC candidates for posts reserved for them \rightarrow 3 years.
- 2. SC/ST candidates for posts reserved for them \rightarrow **5 years.**

- 3. PwD (Gen) \rightarrow 10 years.
- 4. PwD (OBC) \rightarrow 13 years.
- 5. PwD (SC/ST) \rightarrow 15 years.
- 6. Ex-Servicemen (including ECO/SSCO)* \rightarrow 5 years.
- 7. Candidates domiciled in Kashmir between 1st January 1980 and 31st December $1989 \rightarrow 5$ years.
- 8. Eligible staff* \rightarrow as per RBI circular CO. HRMD. No. G-75/5599/05.01.01/2013-2014 dated December 20, 2013.
- 9. Candidates with experience as officer in Commercial Bank/Financial Institution in Public Sector → To the extent of number of completed years subject to a maximum of 3 years.
- 10. Ex-Employees of Banking Institutions whose services had to be terminated for reasons of economy or as a result of bank going into liquidation and personnel retrenched from Government Offices after at least one years' service and currently registered with Employment Exchange \rightarrow **5 years.**
- 11. Candidates possessing M.Phil. qualification \rightarrow 2 years.
- 12. Candidates possessing Ph.D. qualification \rightarrow 4 years.

D. Educational Qualifications:

As on 1st July 2016, you should have:

A minimum of 60% marks (50% in case of SC/ST/PWD) or an equivalent grade in Bachelor's degree as well as in 12th and 10th standard examinations.

The minimum qualifying percentage or an equivalent grade for the Bachelor's Degree will be in aggregate for all semesters/years.

E. Maximum Number of Attempts:

Candidates belonging to the unreserved i.e. General Category, who have already appeared <u>SIX</u> times for Phase I exam for the post of RBI Grade 'B' Officer in the past are not eligible to apply. There is no such restriction for the SC/ST/OBC/PWD if















the posts are reserved for them.

#4. Salary of RBI Grade B Officer

Basic Pay: Rs. 35,150/- pm

Pay scale: Rs. 35150 - 1750(9) - 50900 - EB - 1750(2) - 54400 - 2000(4) - 62400

Gross Monthly Emoluments: Rs. 65,789/- (approx)

Allowances: Dearness Allowance (DA), Local Allowance, House Rent Allowance

(HRA), Family Allowance, and Grade Allowance.

Perquisites: Bank's accommodation subject to availability, reimbursement of expenses for maintenance of vehicle for official purpose, newspaper, telephone charges, book grant, allowance for furnishing of residence, etc. Free dispensary facility, reimbursement of medical expenses for OPD treatment/hospitalization, interest free festival advance, leave fare concession, loans & advances at concessional rates of interest for Housing, Car, Education, Consumer Articles, PC etc. Selected Candidates will be governed by the 'defined contribution New Pension Scheme (NPS)' in addition to the benefit of Gratuity.

For candidates possessing very high academic or professional qualifications and experience of significant value to the Bank, the Bank may, at its sole discretion, consider granting up to four advance increments. It may also consider requests for higher emoluments on account of higher qualification/ special experience of value to the Bank at the Interview Stage only. Such information may be furnished in the Bio-Data form in the appropriate column. The Bank will not entertain any requests received after the interview.

#5. Selection Procedure, Exam Pattern & Syllabus for RBI Grade 'B' Officer Exam

The selection process for RBI Recruitment 2016 will be through **Online Examinations and an Interview**. The online exam will be held in 2 phases.













Phase I: This will be a 200 mark paper with a composite time of 2 hours. It will be an online objective test.

Phase II: Those who qualify through Phase I of the exam are eligible to write Phase II. The exam will be conducted in three shifts of 90 minutes each. You need to appear for all three shifts (papers). Each paper will be worth 100 marks. Phase II is a combination of Online Objective Type and Online Descriptive Type tests.

#6. How to apply

Applications will be accepted via **online** mode only. You will need to fill the online application through the official website of Reserve Bank of India. Here is a step by step process to apply for RBI Recruitment 2016 of Grade 'B' Officers (General):

• To apply online for Grade 'B' Officer posts, visit the link given below.

- Click on the 'Click here for New Registration' button at the top.
- Make sure you meet the eligibility criteria and click on 'Continue'.











- Provide your essential details. Make sure they are correct. Also, make sure to
 use a valid email id and mobile number as these will be used for
 communication of important alerts.
- You will receive a provisional Registration Number and Password. Make sure to note these down and save them.
- Upload your scanned photo and signature meeting the stated requirements.
- Provide basic and personal details regarding yourself. Also provide your qualifications/experiences/languages.
- Preview your entire application carefully.
- Make payment of Rs.850/- (Rs. 100/- for SC/ST/PWD) through ONLINE
