Note: The bank may change the number of vacancies as per its requirement. Also, the reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) and Ex- Serviceman is on horizontal basis.

#5. Eligibility:

(A) EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION (as on 01.07.2016):

- You have to be a graduate in any discipline from a recognized University.
- You must possess the requisite educational qualification as on 01.07.2016.

- You are eligible to apply only if you have passed the qualifying examination on or before 01.07.2016

(B) AGE (as on 01.07.2016):

- Minimum age 18 years & Maximum age 28 years.
- A candidate must have been born not earlier than 02.07.1988 and not later than 01.07.1998 (both days inclusive).

Persons ordinarily domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period 1-1-80 to 31-12-89	5 years
Persons affected by 1984 riots	5 years
Regular employees of the Union Carbide Factory, Bhopal retrenched from service (applicable to Madhya Pradesh only)	5 years

Note: The relaxation in upper age limit to SC/ST/OBC candidates is allowed on cumulative basis.

#6. Selection Procedure:

According to The Bank of Maharashtra Clerk Recruitment Notification, the bank will make the selection in two stages: **Online Test and Document verification.**

ONLINE TEST

The bank will communicate the details of the written test to you in advance. However, the first stage i.e. the **online test**, will be a written test and will be Objective type.

1. PATTERN OF OBJECTIVE TEST:

You will be required to obtain a minimum score in each test of online examination and also minimum total score to be considered to be shortlisted for document verification process. Depending on the number of minimum eligible candidates available, cut-off will be decided by the bank. **The bank will give a relaxation of 5% to the SC/ST/OBC/PWD/XS candidate.**

- On producing a 10th standard mark sheet /certificate evidencing that you have studied official (local) language you will not have to take a **language test**. If you do not possess the proficiency in official (local) language, your candidature will be summarily rejected at any stage.

Note: The questions in objective tests except for the Test of English will be available bilingually, i.e. in English and Hindi. You have to qualify in each section as per cut-off marks determined on the basis of Group Performance in each test. **There will be negative marks for the wrong answers in the Objective Tests. 1/4th marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.**

2. DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND FURTHER PROCESS:

- If you qualify the online test, you will be called for Document Verification. The final selection will depend upon category wise merit in written test and subject to other eligibility criteria.
- After the Document Verification, you will be admitted into the Training Institute for undergoing required **6 months Certified Course at your own expenses**.
- However, if you require, the bank will finance the course through Bank's educational loan scheme.

#6. Application Fee:

The Application Fee is non-refundable. The fee is as follows:

#7. How to Apply:

- You have to apply **online** through the Bank’s website
<http://www.bankofmaharashtra.in>
- You have to go the bank’s website and click on “RECRUITMENT” to open the link “Online application for Admissions to **Clerks** with 6 months course”. You have to then click on the option “APPLY ONLINE” which will open a new screen.
- To register application, choose the tab “Click here for New Registration” and enter Name, Contact details and E-mail id.
- Note that the system will generate a Provisional Registration Number and Password. You will be able to see it on the screen. Note down the Provisional Registration Number and Password.
- Verify the information you fill in the form carefully because the bank will not allow you any changes once you submit the application.

Payment of Fee:

- You have to pay the fees/ intimation charges **online** while submitting the application.

#8. General Instructions:

- You should not submit more than one application.
- In case of multiple applications, the bank will retain only the latest valid (complete) application. However, the application fee/intimation charges paid for the other multiple registration(s) will stand forfeited.

- Multiple attendance/appearances in the online examination and/interview will result in the cancellation of your candidature.

#9. Post-selection Training and Placement:

- The bank intends to employ you in clerical post after successful completion of 6 months **certificate course** specified from the training Institute Manipal Global & /or NIIT-Institute of Finance, Banking & insurance Training Limited a pioneer academic & training institutions.
- **PROGRAMME FEES:**
The Bank of Maharashtra Clerk Recruitment Notification lays out that the fees for the 6 months **certificate course** from Empanelled Institute to be approximately Rs. 1.89 to 1.94 lakh. The fee plus applicable taxes should be borne by you. You have to attend any training Institute/campus as suggested by Bank. Further, you will not have the option to make a choice.
- **FINANCING / LOAN OPTION:**
You can finance course fees by availing an educational loan which will be granted by Bank of Maharashtra. The EMIs for the loan would start on completion of the course duration. The EMIs are spread over a period of 60 months (5 years) so that there is minimal impact in candidate's earnings.
