#### Effluent (noun, adjective)

Hindi translation: प्रवाह, बहनेवाला

Meaning: Liquid waste that flows out of industries, etc. into water bodies.

Memory Tip:  $\mathbf{Ef} - \mathbf{FLU} - \mathbf{ENT} \rightarrow$  "Flowing Pollutant".



Use in Sentence: Industrial effluents flow into rivers and pollute them.









### Exculpate (verb)

Hindi translation: निर्दोष सिद्ध करना

Meaning: To show or declare someone to be blameless.

Memory Tip:  $Ex + culpate \rightarrow Ex + culprit \rightarrow No longer a culprit.$ 



Use in Sentence: They need a strong evidence to exculpate themselves.

## Noisome (adjective)

Hindi translation: द्रगैध, नुकसानदेह

Meaning: Having an extremely foul smell, offensive or unpleasant.

Memory Tip: Noisome → "(an)noy+some" smell.



Use in Sentence: The old man's clothes were noisome as he hadn't washed them in a week.











## Convict (noun, verb)

Hindi translation: मिद्धदोष अपराधी, अपराधी घोषित करना

Meaning: A person who is guilty of a crime, to declare someone guilty.

Memory Tip: Con + vict → कौन + witch (In earlier times, witches were considered to be criminals and were burnt alive.)



Use in Sentence: The man was convicted of robbery.











#### **Conviction** (noun)

Hindi translation: इढ विश्वास

Meaning: 1. An unshakable belief in something without the need for proof. 2. Formal declaration of a person as being guilty of a criminal offence.

Memory Tip: Conviction means believing without proof. But we declare a person convict only after reviewing all proof. How strange!



Use in Sentence: 1. Some people have strong political convictions and opinions. 2. She will appeal against her conviction, in the court.
