#1. Let's go through the Exam Pattern of RBI Assistant first.

#2. Don't forget about Negative Marking.

There is a negative marking of 0.25 marks in RBI Assistant exam for every wrong answer. So make sure that you attempt only those questions which you know correctly otherwise it is better to skip such questions.

#3. Allocate Time Wisely to All the Sections

The objective test consists of 3 subjects. So give an adequate amount of time to all the sections. Since the English language section is easier you can attempt this section at the starting & gain easily score good marks. It will also boost up your confidence level as you













will be able to solve questions easily and quickly. After that, you can go for Numerical Ability section. It will consume about 25 minutes of your time as they are moderately difficult to solve. At the end, you should Reasoning Ability part since it is less time-consuming and will take 20 minutes of your time. You can also have a look at the order of attempt for RBI Assitant. It will give you insights on how to approach each section.

#4. Plan Your Strategy to Attempt the Paper

Everyone has their own strategy of attempting the paper based on their strong & weak points. The best way is to start the paper from that subject in which you have the good command. You can also look at the cutoffs of this year and previous year. It will give you an idea on which section you need to work on more.
