Official SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus for Recruitment 2017

The Staff Selection Commission released a notification to rectruit **8300 vacancies** in various multi tasking posts. The exam will be conducted in 2 stages. Stage 1 will be a Common Examination for all candidates. If you clear this **common test**, you will become eligible to appear for the 2nd stage of the exam – **descriptive paper**. Upon selection, you will be recruited to **General Central Service Group 'C' Non** – **Gazetted, Non** – **Ministerial posts**. Before you go for the exam, it is important for you to know the detailed SSC **MTS** Syllabus 2017 in and out! This article will give you the **official SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus**, as released by the Staff Selection Commission.

This syllabus was released by the staff selection commission within its official SSC Multi Tasking Staff notification. Before we move on to understand the SSC MTS 2017 syllabus, let us first understand the SSC Multitasking staff exam pattern:

SSC Multitasking Staff Exam Pattern

The SSC SSC Multitasking staff recruitment will take place in two stages – written online exam and descriptive exam. Here is the pattern for the written exam:

NOTE:

- 1. Negative marking of 0.25 marks apply as penalty.
- Paper I will consist of Objective Type MCQs only. The que will be set both in English & Hindi. The SSC might set the questions additionally in regional languages, if technical feasible.
- 3. Paper II will be of only those candidates who will meet the cut-off prescribed by the commission in Paper I for various categories.
- 4. Paper II is of <u>qualifying nature</u> and will only test your elementary skills.

Let us now examine the SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus closely.

Official SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus for Recruitment Exam

Indicative SSC Multi Tasking Staff for written examination:

Questions on 'General Intelligence and Reasoning' will be non-verbal considering the functions attached to the post. Questions on Numerical Aptitude and General English will be simple, of a level that an average matriculate will be in a position to answer comfortably. Questions on General Awareness will be also of similar standard.

General Intelligence:

It would include questions of non-verbal type. The test will include questions on similarities and differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discriminating observation, relationship concepts, figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series etc. The test will also include questions designed to test the candidate's abilities to deal with abstract ideas and symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation and other analytical functions.

English Language:

Candidates' understanding of the Basics of English Language, its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonyms, antonyms and its correct usage, etc. his/her writing ability would be tested.

Numerical Aptitude:

This paper will include questions on problems relating to Number Systems,

Computation of Whole Numbers, Decimals and Fractions and relationship between

Numbers, Fundamental arithmetical operations, Percentages, Ratio and Proportion,

Averages, Interest, Profit and Loss, Discount, use of Tables and Graphs,

Mensuration, Time and Distance, Ratio and Time, Time and Work, etc.

General Awareness:

Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's general awareness of the environment around him and its application to society. Questions will also be designed to test knowledge of current events and of such matters of everyday observation and experience in their scientific aspects as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to India and its neighbouring countries especially pertaining to Sports, History, Culture, Geography, Economic scene, General Polity including Indian Constitution, and Scientific











Research etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline.

NOTE: For VH candidates of 40% and above visual disability and opting for **SCRIBE** there will be no component of Maps/Graphs/Diagrams/Statistical Data in the General Intelligence & Reasoning / General Awareness Paper.

<u>Indicative SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus for descriptive</u> examination:

The Paper will be set in English and Hindi and to the extent possible in other languages mentioned in the 8th Schedule of the Constitution as given in Annexure-X, to test basic language skills commensurate with the educational qualification prescribed for the post. Candidates will be required to write one short essay/letter in English or any language included in the 8th schedule of Constitution.

Important instructions regarding the SSC Multi Tasking Staff Syllabus and Exam:

- Candidates must write the papers/indicate the answers in their own hand.
- In the question papers, wherever necessary, the Metric systems of weights and measures only will be used.
- Candidates are not permitted to use calculators and other electronic gadgets except as specified in the Notice. They should not, therefore, bring the same inside the Examination Premises / Venue.
- If any candidate is found to possess mobile phones or any other means of wireless communication in the working or switched off mode, his/her candidature shall be cancelled forthwith.
