# Strategy to Prepare for Indian Bank PO Descriptive Paper

In the descriptive exam of Indian Bank PO, you will have to write:

- 1. An essay
- 2. A letter

for 50 marks, in 30 minutes.

In all probability, the essay will carry 30-35 marks while the letter will be asked for 15-20 marks. To practice for the Indian Bank PO descriptive exam, here are certain points you should know and follow:

- Read the newspaper daily, to develop a good vocabulary and stay in touch with current affairs. The topic for your essay and letter can be anything related to recent events and social issues.
- 2. Write at least 1 letter and 1 essay daily until the exam day. At first, you can take your time and complete your essay or letter in an hour. But slowly, develop your speed and within a week you should be able to complete your letter and essay in 30 minutes.
- 3. Practice by typing on a computer. Developing a good typing speed can help you finish your letter and essay in time.
