#### **Hypothesis**

• This is a noun, which means 'a supposition or proposed explanation'.















- The word has been derived from the Greek word 'hupethesis' meaning foundation.
- The word is formed from two words: 'hupo' (under) + 'thesis' (placing).
- The plural form of the word is 'hypotheses'.
- It does not follow the usual rule of adding 's' at the end of the word to make it plural.

*E.g. The detective's initial hypothesis turned out to be true.* 

#### Lay down

The meanings of lay down are the following:

- 1. To give up and surrender
- 2. To specify
- 3. To place carefully
- 4. To store for the future

In which sense has the phrase been used here?

Ans: 2

**Solution**: Colin Clark specified in detail about his hypothesis. Thus, option 2 is the correct answer.

E.g. The burglar finally laid down his guns in front of the police.
