- The questions from these topics **can be solved very quickly**. Furthermore, the high accuracy is possible in these chapters.

- Due to their easiness, daily practising few sums will ensure full scoring. For this, you should try giving some quizzes on the topics:









- Quiz for Coded Inequalities, Quiz for Syllogisms, Quiz for Coding & Decoding, Quiz for Analogy, Quiz for Classification.

3. How to Prepare Moderate Topics in Reasoning for IBPS RRB

There are some topics in these exams that are of moderate level. These are asked for more marks. These are questions from the topics such as **Blood Relations**, **Directions & Distances**, **Ordering & Ranking**, **Arrangement & Pattern**, **Floor Puzzle** and **Scheduling**. The weightage for the topics is moderate to high. Since there are a lot of questions, there are more chances of acing these questions.

- These topics are the ones which would be easiest to solve **WHILE** being for more marks. Therefore, you must **solve as many as you can** in the exam.
- A lot of these **questions require proper techniques and step-by-step solving**. Come out with your own tricks for the sums you find.
- These questions can be very tricky so you need to be attentive.
- The topics are also time consuming. Practice various tests beforehand to know how much time you spend on each question.

• All arrangement questions **require a lot of daily practice**.









- They are very time consuming. Hence, an **effective time management strategy must be prepared** before the exam.
- They require clean charting with **proper technique and step-by-step solving**.
- Since these questions are puzzle-like, they can be quite tricky. However, moderate to high accuracy is still possible.
- You need to **do the questions that you are familiar with first and know the best**. This will not only give you confidence but also save time.
- In your preparations, you should **try to set a goal of particular puzzles you must solve** in a day.
