Awards and Honors

- Anti-hunger activist awarded by Queen
 - Anti-hunger activist Ankit Kawatra was awarded the Queen's Young Leaders Award for 2017 at a ceremony in Buckingham Palace.
 - He was awarded for his exceptional work towards solving hunger and malnutrition in India by Queen Elizabeth II.
 - He is the founder of Feeding India, that aims to eradicate hunger and food wastage in India.
 - o He was also selected as one of the 17 UN Young Leaders for SDG.
- Uttarakhand gets award of excellence
 - Uttarakhand was conferred with the award of excellence at 2nd Global Skill Development Summit held in Paris.
 - The state was awarded for it's innovations and extensive use of IT for skilling the youth.
 - o Initiatives are being taken to impart high quality job oriented training to the youth so that they could avail of employment opportunities in tourism, wellness, agriculture and security sectors.
- Romania picks a new Prime Minister
 - o Romanian President Klaus Iohannis has nominated the outgoing economy minister Mihai Tudose as the new prime minister.
 - According to Iohannis the decision has been taken to end the current political crisis which harming the economy and country's external image abroad.











- Tudose now has 10 days to gain the vote of confidence in his government and his programme.
- Miss World title in BodyBuilding
 - Bhumika Sharma from Dehradun has become the first Indian woman to win the Miss World Body Building Championship.
 - She won gold in the international championship organized by World Amateur Body Building Association.
 - She defeated 50 women from across the world in the final rounds to clinch the title.
 - She gained the maximum number of points in body posing, individual posing and fall category
- SJFI annual awards winners
 - The Sports Journalists Federation of India has decided to confer the best Sportsperson of the Year Award to the Rio Olympics silver medallist P V Sindhu.
 - o The Best Team of the Year award was bagged by the Indian junior hockey squad which won the World Cup in Lucknow last December.
 - o Both the awards would be presented at the 40th convention of the SJFI to be held in Indore in September.
- Best Parliamentarian Award
 - RSP Leader and Lok Sabha member N K Premachandran has been selected for the Best Parliamentarian Award for 2016.
 - He has been awarded for his contributions towards strengthening parliamentary democracy and upholding traditions & conventions during 2016.
 - Award will be conferred on him by Vice President Hamid Ansari and Lok Sabha Speaker Sumitra Mahajan during the upcoming session of Parliament

- It is the first Indian film ever to win prestigious Jackie Chan award for Best Action Film.
- The film has been directed by Ali Abbas Zafar, also stars Anushka Sharma in lead role.
- Sultan will release in China later this year.
- West Bengal wins UN Public Service Award
 - UN has accorded its highest award for public service to West Bengal govt for it's 'Kanyashree' scheme.
 - Kanyashree is a targeted conditional cash transfer scheme aimed at retaining girls in schools and other educational and skill development institutions along with preventing child marriage.
 - The project was launched in 2011 and has helped more than 40 lakh female students in the state.
- Azim Premji Honoured
 - Azim Premji is among the honorees of this year's Carnegie Medal for for his efforts to reform India's public school system.
 - o It is driven by the Azim Premji Foundation's direct field work, currently serving seven states and over 300,000 schools.
 - o The foundation went on to establish the Azim Premji University in 2011, with a focus on school education and related fields of human development.
- Shrihari Chandraghatgi gets Japan Award
 - o Indian Agricultural Microbiologist Dr Shrihari Chandraghatgi has been conferred with Ministry of Environment Award in Japan for developing cutting edge technologies to address environmental problems.
 - He is the first foreigner to win this award in environmental sector in Japan.











 He has developed technologies by exploring capabilities of natural microorganisms for environmental remediation.

Books and Authors

- Book on democracy's darkest hour
 - Venkaiah Naidu and Gujarat Chief Minister Vijay Rupani released a book "The Emergency - Indian Democracy's Darkest Hour" at Ahmedabad.
 - The book has been written by A Surya Prakash, chairman of Prasar Bharati.
 - The book was launched at a conference to mark the anniversary of the Emergency and to honour those who fought for restoration of democracy in the country in the mid-1970s.
- Book on Atal Bihari Vajpayee unveiled
 - Former Uttarakhand chief minister Ramesh Pokhriyal has unveiled 'Yug Purush, Bharat Ratna, Atal ji' which chronicles the life of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.
 - o The book was presented to President Pranab Mukherjee.
 - o The book is 450 pages long and will be launched soon.
- Indira Gandhi A life in Nature launched
 - o The book "Indira Gandhi A life in Nature" was launched by Congress president Sonia Gandhi at Indira Gandhi Memorial.
 - o Book is authored by Jairam Ramesh and published by Simon & Schuster.
 - o It also showcases how Indira Gandhi led India to the path of conservation and made it a priority of economic development.
 - o It also highlights unexplored aspect of her life and love for nature.
- Ministry of 'Utmost Happiness' launched













- The much awaited second novel of Arundhati Roy "The Ministry of Utmost Happiness" has been launched.
- o Ministry of Utmost Happiness is a complex and a nonlinear narrative.
- o The book is published in India by Penguin Random House.
- Arundhati Roy was the first Indian woman to win the prestigious Booker
 Prize with her 1997 work.

Government Policies and Schemes

- Free electricity for BPL families
 - UP Cabinet Minister Shrikant Sharma has said that under the 'Power For All' scheme all the urban Below Poverty Line families would get free electricity connection.
 - All urban dwellers below the poverty line shall receive free electricity connections.
 - o The 'Power for All' pact was signed in the presence of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and Union Minister of State for Power Piyush Goyal.
- Government launches VAJRA scheme
 - Dept. of Science & Technology has launched VAJRA scheme to bring together Indian scientists abroad and India-based researchers for conducting joint researches in India.
 - VAJRA will boost research work and lead to newer, cutting edge technologies, which was needed in India.
 - Under the scheme foreign researchers would receive endowments at par with those in their own countries.
- Free education from Nursery to PhD
 - Chief minister Capt Amarinder Singh has announced free education for girls from nursery to the doctorate level in government institutions of Punjab.











- Govt will also introduce free textbooks to all students of govt schools, and will introduce pre-primary classes in govt schools from the next academic session.
- He also announced free Wi-FI for 13,000 primary schools and all 48 govt colleges.
- Telangana govt sets up WiFi hotspots
 - o Telangana govt has launched Hyderabad City Wi-Fi project, providing wireless networking technology at over 1,000 public places in Hyderabad.
 - 3,000 public locations were identified in the city, however network has now been installed at 1,000 hotspots with an assured bandwidth of 5-10 Mbps offering 30 minutes of free wi-fi.
 - Entire project is being rolled out at a cost of around Rs 300 crore.
- No departure card from July 1
 - o Govt has decided to discontinue the practice of filling up of the departure card by Indians at all international airports with effect from July 1, 2017.
 - The move is aimed at ensuring hassle-free movement of Indians going abroad.
 - o However, those going out of the country via rail, seaport and land immigration checkposts will have to fill the embarkation card.
- APY can now be subscribed digitally
 - Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority has introduced APY@eNPS which involves complete digital enrolment process.
 - o It has been done to give additional push to cover the unreached population at greater ease.
 - Under APY, subscribers would receive a minimum guaranteed pension at the age of 60 years, depending on their contributions.
 - APY subscribers' base is more than 54 Lakhs.

- Sushma Swaraj inaugurated Know India Programme, for young overseas Indians in New Delhi.
- o It is aimed at promoting awareness on different facets of life in India and progress made by India in various fields such as economic and education.
- o It provides a unique forum for students and young professionals of Indian origin to visit India and develop closer bonds with contemporary India.
- Free education to transgenders in TN
 - The Tamil Nadu Government has announced free education for the transgender community in all the colleges of state's Manonmaniam Sundaranar University.
 - o The decision will be implemented from this academic year.
 - o One seat in every course of all the colleges affiliated to the university has been reserved for the transgenders.
- Online sale of cattle
 - o The Telangana government launched a website to facilitate the buying and selling of cattle online.
 - The state said that the website pashubazar.telangana.gov.in would save the farmers transportation costs, as they need not keep taking them to markets.
 - Each registration on the website will only be valid for 30 days, following which it will be removed automatically.
- Sand scheme after Sonia Gandhi
 - Puducherry government plans to offer cement at subsidised rates to low and middle income people, and name the scheme after Congress President Sonia Gandhi.
 - Since puducherry does not have industries manufacturing cement, so it will be procured from outside and sold at subsidised price.
 - Due to shortage of sand in Puducherry people have to depend on Tamil
 Nadu for sand.













Days and Events

- July 1 to be observed as GST Day
 - Central Board of Excise and Customs has announced that July 1 will be known as 'GST Day'.
 - It will be celebrated in all offices of CBEC just as Central Excise Day and International Customs Day is celebrated.
 - All the offices of CBEC have been instructed to be open on 1st July as a trade facilitation measure.
 - CBEC had organised outreach programmes and training sessions for the new regime.
- National Statistics Day
 - National Statistics Day is observed every year on 29 June, on the occasion of Birth anniversary of India's eminent statistician Late Prof Mahalanobis.
 - Aim of this Day is to create public awareness about importance of statistics in socio-economic planning and policy formulation, to acknowledge the contribution of Prof. Mahalanobis.
 - o Theme for 2017 Statistics Day is Administrative Statistics.

• World's first ATM turns 50

- World's first Automated Teller Machine, a technology which brought transformation in the way people obtained the cash has clocked 50 years.
- World's first ATM was unveiled by Barclays at its Enfield branch in North London on June 27 1967.
- As a tribute, Barclays transformed the ATM at its Enfield branch into gold, added a commemorative plaque and placed a red carpet in front for its users.

- o This day aims to aims to raise awareness of the major problem that illicit drugs represent to society.
- The theme for 2017 is Listen First Listening to children and youth is the first step to help them grow healthy and safe."

International Yoga Day

- Every year June 21 is celebrated as International Yoga Day in different parts of the world.
- The idea of International Day of Yoga was first proposed by PM Modi during his speech at the UNGA, on 27 September 2014.
- o This year's theme 'Yoga for Health' hopes to highlight yoga's holistic approach to both physical and mental well-being and its ability to create a balance between body and mind.

World Refugee Day

- World Refugee Day is held every year on June 20th to raise awareness of the situation of refugees throughout the world.
- On this day, refugee advocates urge people to focus on plight of those who have been displaced by famine and war.
- By the end of 2016, more than 65 million people worldwide were forced to leave their homes due to conflict, data published by the U.N. Refugee Agency reveals.

• World Blood Donor Day

- Every year on 14 June, countries around the world celebrate World Blood Donor Day.
- o It is observed to raise awareness of the need for safe blood and blood products and to thank blood donors for their life-saving gifts of blood.











- It is one of eight official global public health campaigns marked by World Health Organization.
- The theme for 2017 is Give Blood. Give Now. Give Often.
- International Albinism awareness day
 - o International Albinism Awareness day is observed every year on June 13 across the globe with an aim to stop the brutalities against people with albinism.
 - Hundreds of albinos have been brutally murdered and mutilated in African countries in past decades.
 - Albinism is a genetic condition resulting in little or no pigmentation in the skin, hair, and eyes.
 - o It was adopted by UNGA on Dec 18, 2014.
- World Day Against Child Labour
 - The World Day Against Child Labour is held every year on June 12. It is intended to foster the worldwide movement against child labour in any of its forms.
 - o It is an International Labour Organization sanctioned holiday aiming to raise awareness and activism to prevent child labour.
 - World Day Against Child Labour 2017 Theme is "In conflicts and disasters,
 protect children from child labour".
- First World Pest Day launched
 - o The first World Pest Day was launched in Beijing, China.
 - o Its objective is to increase awareness of pest-borne diseases and safeguard public health through scientific and professional pest control methods.
 - More than 30 national and international organisations have signed to support the initiative.
 - The inaugural of World Pest Day was initiated by the Chinese Pest Control Association.

Committees and Recommendations

- Committee on corporate governance
 - To improve standards of corporate governance of listed companies, Sebi has setup a Committee on corporate governance.
 - The committee will be headed by Uday Kotak.
 - o The panel would suggest measures for addressing issues faced by investors on voting and ways for improving effectiveness of board evaluation practices.
 - o It will also suggest Sebi on issues pertaining to disclosure and transparency.

International Affairs

- Romania picks a new Prime Minister
 - Romanian President Klaus Iohannis has nominated the outgoing economy minister Mihai Tudose as the new prime minister.
 - According to Iohannis the decision has been taken to end the current political crisis which harming the economy and country's external image abroad.
 - Tudose now has 10 days to gain the vote of confidence in his government and his programme.
- China's fastest bullet train
 - o China's fastest next generation bullet train "Fuxing" has made its debut on Beijing-Shanghai railway line.
 - The train can achieve speeds as high as 400 km/hour with a consistent speed of 350 km/hour.
 - o It includes a sophisticated monitoring system that constantly checks its performance & automatically slows down the train in case of emergencies.
 - o It has been designed and manufactured in China.











- World's worst cholera outbreak
 - o UN has warned that Yemen is now facing the worst cholera outbreak anywhere in the world with about 1,310 people dying due to the disease since late April.
 - According to a statement by UNICEF and WHO, the number of suspected cholera cases in the country has exceeded 200,000.
 - No part of Yemen has been spared from the cholera outbreak, with an estimated 5,000 new cases every day.
- Egypt's president ratifies islands deal
 - Egypt's president has ratified a disputed 2016 agreement under which his country would transfer control of 2 Red Sea islands to Saudi Arabia.
 - Deal to hand over Tiran and Sanafir was agreed during a visit to Egypt by Saudi King Salman a year ago.
 - The Egyptian govt says that the 2 islands have always been Saudi's, but were placed under Egypt's protection in 1950's amid Arab-Israeli tension.
- Saudi Arabia makes 13 demands to Qatar
 - Saudi Arabia and other Arab countries that have cut ties with Qatar have issued a list of demands to end a major Gulf crisis.
 - o In the 13-point list, countries have demand Qatar to shut down the Al Jazeera network, close a Turkish military base and scale down ties with Iran.
 - They have given Qatar 10 days to comply with all of the demands which include paying an unspecified sum in compensation.
- Facebook Launches UK Initiative
 - Facebook is launching a UK program to train and fund local organizations to combat extremist material online.
 - The new initiative will train NGO's to help them monitor and respond to extremist content and create a dedicated support desk so they can communicate directly with Facebook.











- The program comes in wake of criticism by politicians that tech companies are slow to remove extremist content
- Saudi imposes family tax
 - Saudi Arabia has decided to impose a family tax of 100 riyals per dependent per month on expatriates.
 - o The fee will be implemented from July 1 and is expected to pose a financial burden on over 41 lakh Indian families living in Saudi.
 - It will be doubled to 200 Saudi riyals for every dependent from July 2018, tripled to 300 Saudi riyals in 2019 and quadrupled to 400 Saudi riyals from July 2020
- Best airline in the world
 - Qatar Airways has been named Best Airline in the World for 2017 by consumer aviation website Skytrax.
 - o This is Qatar Airways' fourth win in the last 10 years after securing the top spot in 2011, 2012, and 2015.
 - Qatar Airways also took home the award for Best Business Class in the World and Best Airline in the Middle East.
 - o Two Indian airlines IndiGo and Jet Airways were on the Top 100 list.
- Pakistan begins fencing its border
 - Pakistan will soon begin construction of a fence across its porous border with Afghanistan in order to improve security.
 - o In first phase high infiltration-prone border areas in Bajaur, Mohmand and Khyber are being fenced.
 - New forts and border posts would be built in order to improve surveillance and defense.
 - The 2 nations are divided by 2400km Durand Line, drawn by britishers in 1896.
- World's 1st data embassy













- PM of Estonia Jüri Ratas and PM of Luxembourg Xavier Bettel signed an agreement on housing data and information systems between 2 countries, thereby creating world's 1st data embassy.
- Luxembourg has been chosen as the location for the embassy and will begins its operations from 2018.
- Luxembourg has been chosen since it has capabilities to provide a high level of security for the stored data.

National Affairs

- Kailash Mansarovar yatra cancelled
 - o Kailash Mansarovar yatra through Nathu La in Sikkim has been cancelled.
 - o The decision comes in the wake of face-off b/w Indian and Chinese troops over a disputed area along Sino-Indian border.
 - o The yatra is considered holy by Hindus, Buddhists and Jains and is undertaken by hundreds of pilgrims every year.
 - However the pilgrimage through Lipulekh Pass in Uttarakhand will continue as scheduled
- Training programme COMMIT launched
 - Training programme "Comprehensive Online Modified Modules on Induction Training" for State Govt officials has been launched by Dr Jitendra Singh.
 - It's Objective is to improve public service delivery mechanism & provide citizen centric administration through capacity building of officials who interact with citizens on day-to-day basis.
 - It has been developed by DoPT in collaboration with UNDP
- Web App for Legal Services to Prisoners
 - National Legal Services Authority has launched a Web Application for free Legal Services to Prisoners.

- o It will allow State and District Legal Services Authorities to feed the data for individual prison inmate in the jails within their jurisdiction.
- o Software will generate reports showing total number of inmates, number of inmates represented by legal services lawyers and by private lawyers.
- Modi in Gujarat
 - Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the centenary celebrations of Sabarmati Ashram in Ahmedabad.
 - He will also release the coin and postal stamp in the honour of Shrimad
 Rajchandraji on his 150th birth anniversary at Abhay Ghat.
 - o Modi is on a 2 day visit to Gujarat that goes to elections later this year.
 - o He will inaugurate 2 water supply projects worth Rs 552 crore for the region.
- Printing of Rs 200 currency notes begins
 - RBI has begun printing bills of 200 rupees for the first time to help ease consumer transactions.
 - New 200 notes will carry advanced security features to prevent counterfeiting.
 - o Introduction of 200 rupee notes will replenish the missing middle, triggered by the withdrawal of the old series of 500 rupee notes.
 - o The proposal to issue □200 banknotes was cleared by the RBI in March.
- War room set up to deal with GST crises
 - o A "mini war room" has been set up in the finance ministry to deal with crises related to the implementation of the Goods and Services Tax.
 - o It will act as a quick resource centre for Central and State government officials to address their queries on GST.
 - A team of tech-savvy young officers will be manning the "war room" to assist officials in resolving their GST-related queries.
- Approval for disinvestment of Air India











- Cabinet has given in-principle approval for disinvestment of state-run carrier Air India.
- A group headed by Jaitley will be formed to decide on the treatment of unsustainable debt of Air India.
- NITI Aayog has suggested complete privatisation of Air India which has a debt of over Rs 52,000 crore.
- Air India was launched in 1932 by JRD Tata as Tata Airlines and was taken over by govt in 1953.
- EC to launch voter registration reminder
 - o In order to reach out to maximum eligible voters, the ECI is collaborating with Facebook to launch first Nationwide "Voter Registration Reminder".
 - A notification regarding the reminder will be sent on 1 July to people who are eligible to vote on Facebook.
 - o The reminder will be sent out in 13 Indian languages.
 - This is the first time Facebook has been used for enrolling new voters across India
- Arunachal Pradesh raises retirement age
 - Arunachal Pradesh government has decided to increase the retirement age of regular state government employees to 60 years with effect from January 1 2018.
 - o This has been done in order to do away with differential retirement age for regular employees serving under the same government.
 - The state government has raised the retirement age from existing 58 to 60 years.
- 'Digital MSME' scheme launched
 - o On the occasion of first International Day for MSMEs, Union Minister Kalraj Mishra launched a new shceme 'Digital MSME'.
 - The Scheme has been launched for promotion of Information & Communication Technology in the MSME Sector.













 The scheme revolves around Cloud Computing which is emerging as a cost effective and viable alternative in comparison to in-house Infrastructure installed by MSMEs.

Business and Economy

- EU fines Google 2.42 billion euros
 - on Google for breaching antitrust rules with its online shopping service.
 - Commission found that Google had systematically given prominent placement in searches to its own comparison shopping service and demoted those of rivals in search results.
 - o It is the biggest fine ever for a single company in an EU antitrust case.
- Reliance Industries overtakes TCS
 - Reliance Industries has regained the status of country's most valued firm,
 overtaking Tata Consultancy Services in terms of market valuation.
 - TCS had replaced RIL as the most valued firm more than 4 years ago but a sharp rally in share of RIL in the recent past has helped the company close the gap.
 - o So far in 2017, shares of RIL have gained nearly 33%, while TCS is trading flat, down 0.05%.
- RBI inducts 3 more in oversight panel
 - RBI has expanded the overseeing committee by appointing 3 more members.
 - o The new members are MBN Rao, Y M Deosthalee and S Raman.
 - Pradeep Kumar will head the now 5-member panel that will work through multiple benches.











- The reconstituted OC will work with an expanded mandate to review, in addition to cases being restructured under the Scheme for Sustainable Structuring of Stressed Assets.
- Stricter norms for P-Notes
 - SEBI has tightened P-Note norms by levying a fee of \$1000 on each instrument and barred their issuance for speculative purposes to check any misuse for channelising black money.
 - o P-Notes are issued by registered FPIs to overseas investors who wish to be a part of Indian stock markets without registering themselves directly.
 - Entry norms for foreign portfolio investor has been relaxed by SEBI.
- World's best budget airline
 - o AirAsia has been named the World's Best Low-Cost Airline for the ninth time in a row at the 2017 Skytrax World Airline Awards.
 - The airline was also named Asia's Best Low-Cost Airline in Asia.
 - AirAsia X, AirAsia's long-haul sister airline, bagged the World's Best Low-Cost Airline Premium Cabin and World's Best Low-Cost Airline Premium Seat awards for the fifth straight year.
- India and ADB Sign \$275 Million Loan
 - Asian Development Bank and Govt of India has signed a \$275 million loan for improving urban services in 64 small towns in the State of Madhya Pradesh.
 - The state government will provide a USD 124 million counterpart support for the project which is estimated to be completed by June 2022.
 - It will develop sustainable, inclusive and climate resilient water supply in
 64 small and mid-sized towns.
- Hike Messenger partners with YES Bank
 - Hike Messenger has launched a new version of the app with a completely new interface and addition of a mobile wallet,.

- Hike has partnered Yes Bank to facilitate money transfers to banks using UPI system.
- Wallet will allow instant money transfer among its clients and enable fund transfer to banks using UPI.
- Hike Messenger is the first messaging platform in India to launch payments facility.
- Meghalaya Govt signs two MoUs with SBI
 - Meghalaya govt has signed 2 MoUs with the State Bank of India as a part of an initiative towards migrating government transactions to digital mode.
 - Finance department signed 2 MoUs with the StateBank of India for their SBI ePay and SBI CMP facilities.
 - o SBI CMP will help the state govt to make its payments online and will reduce paper work and manual reconciliation of govt transactions.
- Reliance Definks pact with Yugoimport
 - Reliance Defence Ammunition has entered a strategic partnership with
 Serbia's state-run defence major Yugoimport to manufacture ammunition in India.
 - The Two will work together in the field of ammunition with projected minimum requirement of Rs 20,000 crore over next 10 years from Indian armed forces.
 - Reliance Defence has proposed to set up a greenfield facility for production of ammunition.
- SBI ties up with Tirumala Milk Products
 - o State Bank of India has entered into a tie-up with Tirumala Milk Products.
 - o It's main aim is to provide loans to dairy farmers.
 - Under its scheme for financing dairy units, SBI offers loans for construction of shed, and purchase of milch animals, milking machine, and chaff cutter.













- Tie-**up with SBI is company's** first bank tie-up in India.
- DCB launches Iris scan verification
 - o DCB bank has launched new services India's first Aadhaar based iris eye scan customer verification and fingerprint operated ATM in Telangana.
 - o These services will include a customer's Aadhaar number, eye scan and fingerprint impression.
 - o The ATM also can be used with the usual ATM/ Debit Card.
 - This launch coincides with inauguration of 3 new branches in Mancherial,
 Mothe and Narsapur.
- ClearTax launches GST ready Billbook
 - India's largest Income Tax returns e-filing and enterprise compliance service provider ClearTax has announced the launch of Bill book software for SMEs.
 - o It is a ready-to-use software platform that works both online and offline.
 - Some of its key features include creating a sales invoice, recording of discount and insurance.

- o It is a hybrid planet-star, has mass of Planet and an atmosphere like a star.

Apple unveils new operating system

- Apple has unveiled iOS 11, a new and advanced operating system for its devices.
- o It features a "Do Not Disturb while Driving" mode that turns iPhone screens black and stops users from replying to messages.
- o It includes a more helpful Siri, phone-to-phone payments within iMessage and a control centre that collates all functions in one place.
- It will be available in Autumn.

ISRO launches heaviest rocket

- o ISRO launched India's heaviest rocket GSLV-Mk III along with a communications satellite GSAT-19 from Satish Dhawan Space Centre.
- o The 43.43m rocket that weighs 640 tonnes is capable of lifting payloads of up to 4000 kg into Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit.
- The rocket's cryogenic engine has been developed by space scientists indigenously.
- o It was developed in 15 years at a cost of □300 crore.















- LIGO makes Gravitational Wave Detection
 - Laser Interferometer Gravitational Wave Observatory detectors have detected another merger of 2 black holes.
 - o GW150914, is the 3rd confirmed detection of gravitational waves coming from a binary black hole merger.
 - The detection has revealed not only a black hole merger, but also alignment of the spins of black holes.
 - o GW170104, GW151226 and GW150914 are the 3 confirmed detections by LIGO.
- NASA to launch Sounding Rocket
 - NASA will launch a sounding rocket which will release blue-green and red artificial clouds.
 - The rocket will eject vapour canisters between 10 to 20 km from the rocket's main payload.
 - o The vapor tracers will allow scientists on the ground to view the movement of the particles in the ionosphere.
 - The sounding rockets are short lived and follows a parabolic trajectory.

 - o Pakistan won the 2017 Champions Trophy cricket final after beating archrivals India by 180 runs at the Oval ground in Britain's capital, London.
 - With the win, Pakistan won their first Champions Trophy to add to their
 1992 World Cup and 2009 World T20 wins.













- Pakistan had come into the tournament as the lowest-ranked team and lost heavily to India in its opening group match.
- India's biggest win over Pakistan
 - o India demolished Pakistan 7-1 to register their third consecutive victory and seal a place in the quarter-finals of the Hockey World League Semi-Final.
 - o This was India's biggest over Pakistan, bettering the 7-4 effort against arch-rivals in 2003 Champions Trophy and 2010 Commonwealth Games.
 - o This was India's 56th win over Pakistan in the 168th match between the two nations.

Environment

- Environmental Impact Survey
 - Mozambique, rated as one of the poorest country has topped a survey of nations with the lowest global environmental impact.
 - o It topped the list as all its energy use comes from green sources.
 - o India was placed 75th with renewable energy making up only 15.2 per cent of all energy used.
 - Africa as a continent topped the charts while Trinidad and Tobago stood at the bottom.
- Facebook Launches 'Disaster Maps'
 - Facebook has launched disaster maps, an initiative aimed at helping humanitarian organisations save lives in emergencies.
 - Maps will reflect the movements and location of people before, during and after disasters to help aid agencies work out where they should deliver food, water and medical supplies.

- o It can take up to 8,000-tonne ships with draught up to 7m, including submarine.
- FDN-2 will move to Andaman & Nicobar Islands to be used for assets not only of Navy but also of other Services.
- CRPF launches helpline 'Madadgaar'
 - Central Reserve Police Force has launched a 24×7 helpline "Madadgaar" at Srinagar's Tagore Hall.
 - The aim of the helpline is to assist Kashmiris, especially students studying all over the country who face security issues and other problems away from the home.

- First Indian PM to visit Israel
 - Narendra Modi will become the first Indian PM to visit Israel with his 3 day visit starting July 4.
 - Visit not only marks 25 years of diplomatic relations b/w the 2 countries but also a definite shift in India's approach towards Israel.
 - Modi will meet Israeli PM Netanyahu over a period of 2 days to discuss matters of mutual interest.
 - o India is the largest buyer of Israeli military equipment.
- India gives \$100,000 to UN Tax Fund











- India has become the first country to voluntarily contribute \$100,000 to a UN fund to help developing countries actively participate in the discussion of tax issues.
- Voluntary contributions for the fund have been called for by the UN and the committee since its establishment in 2006.
- o The fund aims to support the work of the Committee of Experts on International Cooperation in Tax Matters.
- Top supplier in health sector to UN
 - According to UN, India continues to be the main supplier in health to UN system with USD 803.79 million within the health sector in 2016.
 - India supplied 6% of procurements by UN organisations in 2016, second highest after US.
 - Procurement from India included food, management services and medical equipment.
 - Goods and services from India were procured primarily by UNICEF,
 PAHO, UNDP and WFP.
- India and Netherlands sign 3 agreements
 - o India and the Netherlands have signed three agreements, including a memorandum of understanding on water cooperation.
 - India and Netherlands signed MoU's on Cultural Cooperation and on Water Cooperation and an agreement on Amending Social Security Arrangement.
 - The two countries are marking the 70th anniversary of establishment of their diplomatic ties this year.
- Mexico, India to hold disarmament meet
 - India and Mexico have agreed to hold a conference on regional and global disarmament.
 - The meeting would be headed by the Joint Secretary of the disarmament division of the Ministry of External Affairs from the Indian side.











- The latest consultations are aimed at upgrading the Privileged Partnership formed in 2007 to a strategic level as agreed upon during Modi-Nieto meeting of 2016.
- Aadhaar not valid for travel to Nepal
 - According to Home Ministry Aadhaar card is not a valid identification document for Indians travelling to Nepal and Bhutan.
 - o Indians can travel to Nepal and Bhutan if they possess a valid national passport or election ID card issued by the Election Commission.
 - Persons over 65 and below 15 years can show documents with photographs to confirm their age and identity.
- India and Portugal signs 11 MoUs
 - India and Portugal have signed 11 MOUs for cooperation in areas including taxation, science, youth affairs and trade.
 - The 2 sides also signed MoUs for creation of an India Portugal Space Alliance for advancing collaborative research and launched a startup Portal - India-Portugal International StartUp Hub.
 - India and Portugal also agreed to set up science and technology fund of 4 million euros
- India re-elected to ECOSOC
 - o India has been re-elected to the UN's principal organ on economic, social and environmental issues for another three-year term.
 - India was among 18 nations to win election to the Economic and Social Council.
 - India received 183 of the 188 votes, the second highest after
 Japan who received 185 vote in the Asia Pacific category.
 - o Pakistan received just a single vote for the ECOSOC.
- India to host AIIB's 3rd annual meeting
 - o India will host the third annual meeting of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank in 2018.













- The third annual meeting of the AIIB's board of governors will be held in Mumbai in June 2018.
- o The first annual meeting was held in Beijing last year.
- AIIB is a multilateral development bank initiated by China which aims to provide financing for infrastructure improvement in Asia.
- Sikkim signs MoU with British Council
 - HRD department of Sikkim govt has signed an MoU with British Council to enhance quality of education in the state.
 - MoU will improve educational structure of the schools and will revolutionise Sikkim's education.
 - It aims is to support aspirations of young people through collaborative projects in area of English, education & skills by strengthening capacity of teachers and other professionals.

- It aims to create mass awareness about the most effective and low-cost diarrhoea treatment.
- Centre to set up 100 AYUSH hospitals
 - Centre has approved the proposals for setting up of 100 Ayurveda, Unani,
 Siddha & Homeopathy hospitals across the country.
 - Posting of 4000 AYUSH doctors have been approved by Union Govt in last 3 years.
 - An AYUSH hospital equivalent to AIIMS would be opened within a month at New Delhi.
 - Ministry has also approved setting up of two 50-bed integrated AYUSH hospitals at Theni and Tiruvannamalai.
- National Human Milk Bank inaugurated
 - Health Secretary C K Mishra inaugurated Vatsalya Maatri Amrit Kosh, a National Human Milk Bank and Lactation Counselling Centre at Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi.
 - It will collect pasteurise, test and store milk donated by lactating mothers and make it available for infants in need.
 - Vatsalya is established in collaboration with Norwegian government, Oslo University and NIPI.

- Quikr acquires Babajob
 - o Quikr India has acquired job listing company Babajob Services in an attempt to strengthen its position in the blue collar jobs segment.
 - o This the 11th acquisition for Quikr and its second in the online jobs marketplace space.
 - o The combined entity of Babajob and QuikrJobs will become the largest platform for blue collar job seekers.













- Ouikr has decided to run Babajob as a separate entity.
- Canara Bank, New India tie up
 - o Canara Bank and New India Assurance Company have entered into a corporate agency arrangement for distribution of insurance products.
 - o Under the agreement, New India Assurance will offer leading general insurance products to the customers of Canara Bank.
 - o Tie-up will also offer personal products such as motor insurance, home insurance besides commercial policy coverages like fire insurance.
- Microsoft acquires Hexadite
 - Microsoft has confirmed that it has acquired Hexadite, an Israeli startup that uses AI to identify and protect against attacks.
 - Hexadite will develop security solutions for commercial Windows 10 customers, specifically with Windows Defender Advanced Threat
 - Other security acquisitions Microsoft has made in Israel include Aorato,
 Adallom and Secure Islands.
- RCom-Aircel merged wireless company
 - Reliance Communications Chairman Anil Ambani has announced that the merged entities of RCom and Aircel will be called Aircom.
 - Both R-Com and Maxis will hold 50% each in Aircom.
 - As part of this transaction, RCom's overall debt will reduce by Rs 14,000 crore.
 - o The merged entity will have the second largest spectrum holding amongst all operators.

- Blood transfusion facility for cattle blood will also be done at the proposed blood bank which will prevent death of cattle during deliveries.
- Sharjah named World Book Capital

 - It has been chosen by an international committee of UNESCO experts for the quality of its literary and cultural activities and its efforts to make books accessible to the entire population of the country.
 - Sharjah will also launch Sharjah Publishing City, a space entirely dedicated to publishing and printing.
- Uttarakhand, Haryana become ODF
 - Uttarakhand and Haryana have become the fourth and fifth Open
 Defecation Free states of India under the Swachh Bharat Mission.
 - The two states joined the league of Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh and Kerala,
 which were the first three states to be declared ODF.
 - Over two lakh villages and 147 districts have been declared Open
 Defacation Free across the country.
- 1st Indian building to get trademark
 - 114-year-old Taj Mahal Palace in Mumbai has become the 1st Indian building to get trademark.
 - It has joined the elite club of trademarked properties in the world which includes the Empire State Building, the Eiffel Tower and Sydney Opera House.
 - With IHCL trademarking the building, nobody can now use Taj Mahal Palace's images for commercial purposes without paying the company a licensing fee.
