#### Anderson reaches 500 Test match wickets

- James Anderson became the sixth bowler and first Englishman to take
   500 Test wickets.
- He achieved this feat when he dismissed West Indies opener Kraigg
   Brathwaite on the second day of the third Test at Lord's.
- Anderson took 129 matches to break 500 and those wickets came at just over 27 runs apiece.
- o He also has 269 wickets in 194 ODIs to his name.

#### Sandhu wins his fifth consecutive title

- Former Indian men's national squash champion Harinder Pal Sandhu won his fifth professional title in a row when he emerged victorious at the 10th leg of the Malaysian Tour.
- o The World No. 66, who was the top seed at this tournament, edged the 2nd seeded Mohd Syafiq Kamal of Malaysia, 11-8, 10-12, 11-3, 9-11, 11-6 in final to win the title.
- This is Sandhu's 10th international triumph overall.

#### SANKALP SE SIDDHI exhibition

- Union Minister of Petroleum & Gas Shri Dharmendra Pradhan has inaugurated the SANKALP SE SIDDHI exhibition and conducted pledge meeting in Bhubaneswar.
- On this occasion, he recalled various incidences of freedom struggle of India and Quit India Movement call given by Gandhiji.
- Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Ministry of Coal and DAVP of Ministry of I&B have jointly organized the program.

#### • Two Indian Naval Ships depart

- In pursuant of India's Act East Policy, 2 Indian Naval Ships proceeded on deployment to East & South-East Asia
- o INS Satpura & INS Kadmatt, departed from Visakhapatnam for a deployment of more than 3 months, to visit 12 ports
- During this deployment, ships will participate in International Fleet
   Review hosted by ASEAN countries at Thailand
- Ships will also participate in the HADR at Malaysia

## Johnson & Johnson's paternity leave

- Johnson & Johnson India has rolled out a new global parental leave for its Indian workforce.
- As part of this new initiative, new and adoptive fathers will now be entitled to 8 weeks of paid leave during the first year to bond with the newborn or newly adopted child.
- The company has been offering up to 26 weeks of maternity leave for the last six years.

## Nadella pens book on Microsoft journey

 Satya Nadella, one of the most celebrated Indians in the global technology sector, has penned the inside story of his journey of becoming the CEO of software giant Microsoft.















- The book, titled 'Hit Refresh' is co-authored by Greg Shaw and Jill Tracie Nichols.
- The title draws inspiration from the digital world where the screen is refreshed by hitting the function 'F5' key.

#### • Water ATM in Hyderabad

- Safe Water Network, an international NGO has partnered with Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation to launch water ATMs, providing affordable, 24x7 safe water access in Hyderabad.
- o A total of 200 ATMs will be set up to reach a targetted 150,000 people.
- o Consumers can collect water that is affordably priced at ₹1 per glass, ₹2 per litre, ₹5 per 10 litres, and ₹10 per 20 litres.

#### North East Calling festival in New Delhi

- Minister of State in the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region
   Jitendra Singh will inaugurate the "North East Calling" festival in New
   Delhi.
- The two-day event is being organized by Ministry of DoNER under its
   Destination North East series for this year.
- The purpose of the event is to promote the art, culture, heritage, cuisine, handicrafts, business & tourism of North East India.

### • Bharat Petroleum to get Maharatna status

- Bharat Petroleum Corporation is all set to become a Maharatna company.
   The company is at present a Navratna firm. Decision to elevate BPCL to
   Maharatna status was taken by a panel headed by Cabinet secretary.
- After becoming a Maharatna firm, board of BPCL will get enhanced powers which will help in expansion of operations, both in India & abroad.
- o At present, there are 7 Maharatna companies.

## Karnataka tops in manufacturing















- According to a study by industry chambers Assocham, Karnataka stands at top among the states in terms of manufacturing excellence.
- Karnataka has the best manufacturing process ratio of 2.63, with a maximum value of goods being converted into finished goods valuing over Rs 2,000 cr.
- Karnataka ranks 3rd in attracting investments in the manufacturing sector, leaving states like Gujarat behind.

## • Army to induct women in military police

- The government has decided to recruit women jawans into the Army's
   Corps of Military Police for investigating gender specific crimes.
- The plan is to induct approximately 800 women in military police with a
   yearly intake of 52 personnel per year.
- Currently, women are allowed in select areas such as medical, educational, legal, signals and engineering wings of Indian Army

## • India slaps countervailing duty

- India has slapped countervailing duty for a period of 5 years on certain
   Chinese flat steel products to guard domestic players from imports that are subsidized by the exporting nation
- Decision to impose CVD was taken by the finance ministry after the DGAD's recommendation
- It will strengthen the efforts of Indian industry to move towards
   100% quality regime for better safety & health of users

## • Pandey appointed interim GSTN chairman

- The Unique Identification Authority of India's CEO A.B. Pandey has been appointed as the interim chairman of the goods and services tax network.
- Pandey was given additional charge days after GSTN's first chairman
   Navin Kumar completed his term on 29 August.
- GSTN is the firm providing information technology backbone and portal for registration and tax returns under the GST regime.















#### • BCCI releases its players handbook

- The Board of Control for Cricket in India has released its first ever players handbook in New Delhi.
- The book titled '100 things every professional cricketer must know', was released by the Committee of Administrators & is in line with the recommendations of the Lodha panel.
- The document will be the official handbook for all the cricketers registered with the BCCI.

#### • WB approves changing state's name

- Cabinet ministers in West Bengal have cleared a proposal to name the state Bangla. State will be renamed Bangla, & will be called so in all languages
- CM Mamata Banerjee had earlier proposed that WB be named Bangla in Bengali, Bangal in Hindi & Bengal in English, but centre rejected the proposal
- State wants to change its name because WB is always last in list of states in alphabetical order

## Tighter ratings agency rules

- Capital markets regulator SEBI has proposed additional changes to credit rating agencies, including a restriction on cross-holdings & spinning off non-ratings businesses
- The new proposals include requiring rating agency to hive off any other business it does
- Sebi also proposed that rating agency should not hold more than 10% shares or voting rights & representation on board of a rival

## • Govt approves Army's cadre review policy

 The government has approved a long-awaited cadre review policy for Junior Commissioned Officers and other rank-holders in the Army.















- It will offer higher career progression to nearly 1.45 lakh personnel of the force.
- o The upgradation would take place over a span of five years.
- The decision was conveyed to former Army chiefs by incumbent General Bipin Rawat at the biennial Chiefs' Conclave.

#### • India keeps off 'Bali Declaration'

- In a show of solidarity with Myanmar, India refused to be a part of a declaration adopted at an International conference in Indonesia
- India refused to be a part of the declaration as it carried "inappropriate" reference to violence in Rakhine State
- India reiterated its stance that the purpose of convening the Parliamentary
   forum was to arrive at a mutual consensus for implementation of SDGs

#### Govt introduces rules for No Fly List

- Civil Aviation Minister Ashok Gajapathi Raju has released India's first 3tier rules for a national no-fly list.
- In the new rules, unruly behaviour has been categorised into three levels verbal, physical and life threatening.
- o The degree of offence will be decided by an independent committee led by a retired District Judge within a period of 30 days of the incident.

## • PNB, BSNL join hands for mobile wallet

- Punjab National Bank & BSNL have teamed up to roll out open mobile wallet Speedpay across 10 states in the country.
- PNB's Speedway wallet will operate like any other mobile wallet for paying bills, recharging phone besides its users will be able to deposit and withdraw money from authorised retail outlets.
- Speedway users will be able to operate Internet banking services from the application.
