- This will directly enable 'Mission Indradhanush' of the Govt of India

Dilli Seminar 2017 at Naval Academy

- The 2017 edition of the annual Dilli seminar on 'India and Southeast Asia –
 Maritime Trade, Expedition and Civilisation Linkages' commenced at the Indian Naval Academy.
- The seminar is being attended by a large delegation of serving senior Naval and Coast Guard officers.
- The seminar, continues to serve its purpose of apprising the Indian Naval Academy cadets about the rich maritime history.

• Celebrations of Gandhi's 150 anniversary

- Government of India will commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma
 Gandhi, during the period from 2nd October, 2019 to 2nd October, 2020.
- It has been decided to celebrate the event at both national and international levels, to propagate the message of the Mahatma.
- A National Committee headed by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has been constituted for this purpose.

• Bharti Airtel to buy Tata Teleservices

The Tata Group has agreed to sell its mobile business to Bharti Airtel BSE.

• Indian Naval Ships visit Sasebo, Japan

- Indian Naval Ships Satpura and Kadmatt are visiting Sasebo, Japan from 12th to 15th October 2017.
- It is done in pursuance of India's Act East Policy and demonstration of India's commitment to peace and stability in the Indo-Pacific Region.
- The visit is part the Indian Government's initiatives to strengthen the long standing, mutually supportive and strong relationship between Japan and India

• NBFC bad loans rise to 5% in 5 years

- The Reserve Bank of India has said that the NBFCs, key players in the financial spectrum, have witnessed a steady deterioration in asset quality in the past five years.
- Gross non-performing assets ratio for NBFCs increased to 5% at end-March 2017 from 2.9% at end-March 2012.
- Bad loans of NBFCs work out to around Rs 74,230 crore as the advances by the sector were Rs 14.84 lakh crore.

Int. Railway Equipment Exhibition

- Bharat Earth Movers Limited, a Public Sector Company under Ministry of Defence is participating in International Railway Equipment Exhibition-2017.
- It is a three day event being held at Pragati Maidan, from 11 13 October, 2017.
- IREE is India's largest international event for the Railway Sector. BEML is the Nation's first Rail coach manufacturing Company.

• "Make in India: Sweden 2017"

- Make in India: Sweden 2017, organized by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion in Stockholm, from October 12-13 aims to enhance Indo-Swedish cooperation.
- o Delegation is led by the Minister of Commerce & Industry, Shri Suresh Prabhu.

· Pakistan's Football Federation suspended

- The Pakistan football federation was suspended from FIFA by the Bureau of FIFA council.
- o The reason behind the suspension was the "Interference of third party" in PFF.
- The PFF accounts and their offices were under the control of an administrator appointed by court and this actually violated the rules of FIFA.

• Ashish Nehra announces retirement

- Ashish Nehra announced that, he will be retiring from all forms of cricket, after the first Twenty20 international between India and New Zealand.
- Ashish Nehra made his senior debut for India, during the Test series against Sri
 Lanka in 1999. He is 38 years old.
- Ashish Nehra has collected 44 Test, 157 one-day international and 34 Twenty20 wickets in his 18-year international career.

Yuvraj Sing becomes Laureus' ambassador

- Yuvraj Singh has become the first Indian ambassador of Laureus.
- Laureus works to improve the lives of young people through sport, and uses the power of sport to end violence, discrimination and disadvantage.
- Laureus consists of Indian cricket legends like Sachin Tendulkar, Rahul Dravid and Kapil Dev.

Prakash Raj receives Karanth award

- Prakash Raj, actor and film-maker, received the Kota Shivaram Karanth Huttura
 Prashasti award, at the Kota Shivaram Karanth Theme Park, Karnataka.
- o The award is instituted in the name of Jnanpith awardee K Shivaram Karanth.
- It is given by the Kotatattu gram panchatyat in Kota, the birthplace of the literary giant, K Shivaram Karanth, in Udupi district of Karnataka.

Think-tank to achieve oil & gas targets

 Minister for Petroleum and Natural Gas, Dharmendra Pradhan announced the formation of an internal 'think-tank', consisting of experts.

- Its aim will be to advise on technology and build a successful gas network in India.
- The think tank will be in an advisory role and will look after gas infrastructure, financing model for projects, price competitiveness etc.

• GIC re launches India's 3rd largest IPO

- India's biggest reinsurer, General Insurance Corp of India's Rs. 11,370 crore
 Initial Public Offer opened for subscription.
- GIC Re's IPO is Indian primary market's third largest IPO after Coal India
 (Rs.15,200 crore in 2010) and Reliance Power (Rs. 11,600 crore in 2008).
- Funds raised through this IPO will be used by GIC Re for augmenting the capital base and support business growth.

• SBI launches SME Assist

- State Bank of India launched a new product called 'SME Assist' to provide a short-term working capital demand loan to its MSME clients.
- o The loans shall be provided on the basis of clients' input credit claims under GST.
- These loans will help clients to manage their working capital requirement till the time they get input credit and will thereby ensure stability in operations.

• UP launches 'Sankalp Seva' bus service

- Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Aditynath flagged off 50 buses under the
 'Sankalp Seva' bus service in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.
- o The buses launched under 'Sankalp Seva' bus service will connect 6,000 villages.
- This is a initiative to provide better bus services to the people, so that, everyone will have access to all kind of facilities.

• Indian Handicrafts and Gifts Fair

- The 44th edition of Indian Handicrafts and Gifts-Delhi Fair is being held at India
 Expo Centre and Mart on outskirts of Delhi in Greater Noida.
- It is being organised by Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts and inaugrated by Smriti Irani.
- The 5-day B2B IHGF Fair is the biggest platform for promotion of handicrafts business. More than 100 countries are participating in it.

• India 100th on global hunger index

- India got 100th position among 119 countries on Global Hunger Index 2017.
- This year India slipped by three positions as compared to 97th rank in 2016 GHI.
- GHI is a multi dimension measure that describes state of hunger situation on regional, national and global level. It is published annually by International Food Policy Research Institute.
