How to Increase Speed in Reasoning

Reasoning is all about the process of thinking about something in a logical way. It is taken basically to test the judgment skills, the sharpness of mind and logical capacity of the candidate.

While preparing for any banking examinations, there is always a battle between speed and accuracy. The dilemma is what matters the most? Attempting maximum questions shouldn't be your priority but for a successful candidate the priority is to attempt maximum accurately. Thus, accuracy plays an important role for the final merit of any exam. Just keep in mind that High speed with least accuracy is more perilous though speed along with accuracy is an added benefit.

Banking exams include reasoning in every tier as this is the only section wherein the aspirants are judged on the basis of their logical thought process and their ability to

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solve the real world problems. This is the section that can fetch good marks if attempted properly. So, concentration is the best instrument to enhance your speed and accuracy. This is the only section which checks your decision – making ability and speed using limited inputs.

But before starting to know how to Increase Speed in Reasoning, an aspirants should be well acquainted with the syllabus and then should proceed in a structured format.

Increase Speed in Reasoning in following Topics

The topics that are included in banking reasoning along with their weightage are given below:

- Invest some seconds over a question and analyze the given information carefully. Never assume any information
- Information management, flexibility in approach and innovative and flexible thinking is must to crack the reasoning section.
- Solve previous year's papers with patience and awareness. It will familiarize you with the kind of excellent questions and the difficulty level.
- Do not look at the solution. Try for hours and think from all the different perspectives.

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- Having solved the enough number of questions, try and analyze where you lack. Try to identify the section you are most comfortable with and which ones you are not.
- Make a note of different models and the tricks to solve them, so that you can revise it later.
- Don't neglect the unanswered and wrongly attempted questions.
- Pick out the easier Caselet. Don't just blindly solve what comes in sequence. If you are unable to crack in 5 6 minutes, skip it and move on to the next.



LR problems are usually 'all – or – nothing types". The main focus should be on the solution. Direction sense, number, ranking, series completion, etc. should be attempted first they are less consuming. Syllogisms, blood relations, etc. comes next and puzzles or











crosswords at last. An aspirant should divide the topics on the basis of difficulty level and time it requires and thus prepare accordingly.

Divide All Questions in Reasoning Section into Two Categories -

- <u>Easy and Scoring Questions</u>: Start with this section as it requires less time and high accuracy can be attained. The topics included are: - Syllogisms, Blood Relations, Inequalities, Directions, Data Sufficiency Questions of Reasoning, Rows and Verbal Logical Deductions
- <u>**Time Consuming Questions:**</u> Questions are difficult in this category. Accuracy depends on your level of practice. The topics included are: - Seating Arrangements, Puzzles, and Machine Input/Output.

Few Other Important Tips to Increase Speed in Reasoning -

- <u>Inequality</u>: In order to solve questions based on this topic, try using 'King, Soldiers and Public' technique, wherein,
 - King is more powerful than soldiers and Soldiers are more powerful than Public
 - 2. And when a conflict arouse between 2 kings or 2 soldiers, No Conclusion is reached
 - 3. Let, King mean "< or >"; Soldier mean " \geq or \leq "; Public Mean " = "
 - 4. Two opposite signs together will lead to a wrong conclusion i.e. when 2 kings or 2 soldiers faces each other, leading to the fact that the Conclusion will be wrong.
- <u>Distances & Directions</u>: The questions of this particular topic are less time consuming with high accuracy. Remember directions i.e. NEWS: North, East, West, South and other four directions.

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- Puzzles & Seating Arrangement: This topic is the most confusing and time consuming part of the reasoning section. At most 5 6 questions come with a single puzzle quiz. These are of various types like: -
 - 1. Circular / Linear / Square Arrangement
 - 2. Floor Based
 - 3. Scheduling (Days, Months)
 - 4. Parallel sitting arrangement

Initial 2 - 3 statements become a difficulty in solving reasoning puzzles, as there will be multiple sequences possible. Try to generate as much sequence as it occurs and don't leave a single one. Start with that point about which much information is given. By the time you reach the last statement, one sequence will be left and the rest will cancel out. So, in order to get command in this particular topic, practice 10 – 15 puzzle of various types on daily basis.

- 1. Remember four main directions : North, East, West, South
- Remember four cardinal directions : North East, North West, South East, South – West
- 3. At the time of sunrise, if a man stands facing the east, his shadow will be towards the west.
- 4. At the time of sunset, the shadow of an object is always in the east
- 5. If a man stands facing the North, at the time of sunrise his shadow will be towards his left and at the time of sunset it will be towards his right
- 6. At 12:00 noon, the rays of the sun are vertically downward hence there will be no shadow
- <u>Coding & Decoding: -</u> Look at the numbers and alphabets, check the order of the sequence i.e. ascending or descending. Look for rules and tricks that might











follow and do continuous practice. Coding and decoding can be of following types: -

- 1. Alphabet type
- 2. Numerals type
- 3. Symbol and numerals type
- 4. Group of words type
- 5. Reasoning type
- <u>Syllogism: -</u> In this sets, two or more statements followed by two or more conclusions are given. You need to choose the conclusion that fits logically. The basic approach would be as follows: -

Always try to draw the least possible Venn diagram and then try inferring the conclusion given.

- <u>**Blood Relations:**</u> Drawing a tree diagram will help you better solving the problems of blood relationship
 - 1. Mother's or Father's Brother Uncle
 - 2. Mother's or Father's Sister Aunt
 - 3. Brother's or Sister's Son Nephew
 - 4. Brother's or Sister's Daughter Niece
 - 5. Uncle or Aunt's Son or Daughter Cousin
 - 6. Use '+' for male and ' ' for female

A calculation is a vital part in any banking exam as it comes in some of the reasoning ability questions. And speed increases as per your understanding of the topic. The more you understand any topic; the better will be your problem solving ability and then the speed will increase automatically. So, speed is nothing but the byproduct of practice + understanding. Don't practice until you get it right. Practice until you can't get it wrong.
