- Moderate to difficult, Time Consuming, Moderate Accuracy Possible
- **Question Types:** Line Graphs, Bar Graphs, Pie Charts, Tabular Graph, Mix of any two type of DI (mentioned till now), Missing DI, Radar Graph, Caselets. Also, the DI can be based on the concept of Boat & Stream, Time & Work, Profit & Loss etc. to make it tricky.
- **Tips:** How to Quickly Solve Pie Chart DI, Missing Data Problems, Tips for Line Graphs, Tips for Maximum-Minimum Problems in DI
- Quizzes: Quiz 1, Quiz 2

(2) Data Sufficiency

- Weightage: 7-10 Questions

- Moderate to difficult, Less time consuming, Moderate Accuracy possible, Very likely to appear.
- **Question Types:** Reverse Syllogism, possibility based, negative information based.
- Tips: <u>Basic Concepts of Syllogisms</u>

(2) Coding & Decoding

- Weightage: 3-5 Qs
- Moderate in Difficulty, Moderate Time Consuming, High Accuracy possible.

- **Tips:** 3 Tricks for Directions & Distances

(5) Ordering & Ranking

- Weightage: 3 Qs
- Easy to Moderate in difficulty, Less time consuming, High Accuracy possible.
- **Question Types:** Floor Based Puzzles, Box based puzzle, Arranging by age, height, weight, rank, order in row etc.
- Tips: Tricks to Crack Ordering & Ranking

(6) Blood Relations

- Question Types: Number arrangement, Random sequence of alphabets etc.

(12) Scheduling

- Weightage: 5 Qs
- Moderate to Difficult, Could be tricky, Moderate to Highly Time Consuming, Moderate Accuracy possible, Requires clean charting with proper technique and step-by-step solving.
- Question Types: 5 month 2 dates & one more variable based problem.
- Quizzes: Quiz 1, Quiz 2

(13) Linear Seating Arrangement

- Weightage: 5-8 Qs
- Moderate to Difficult, Could be tricky, Moderate to Highly Time Consuming, Requires clean charting with proper technique and step-by-step solving.
- **Question Types:** Single or Double rows facing each other in the same/opposite direction with one more variable. May be mixed up with other information like Blood Relations, Order & Ranking to make it tricky.

(14) Circular Seating Arrangement

- Weightage: 2-5 Qs
- Moderate to Difficult, Moderate to Highly Time Consuming, Moderate to High Accuracy possible.
- **Question Types:** Uni & Bi-directional problems on circular, square, rectangular, hexagonal tables. It may be a square inside a square or circle within a circle and persons sitting in smaller square facing outside & in bigger square are facing inside.
- Tips: How to Approach Circular Arrangements, Circular Arrangements Pt 2

(15) Puzzle

- Weightage: 5-10 Qs
- Difficult, Could be tricky, Moderate to Highly Time Consuming, Moderate Accuracy possible.

IBPS PO Mains Syllabus - English Language

This section 35 Qs in 40 minutes of time duration. The English Syllabus for IBPS PO Mains is pretty much the standard Banking exam fare, except for a few changes in question type here and there. The section can be broadly divided into:

(1) Reading Comprehension


- Weightage: 8-10 Qs (2 sets of Passage)
- Moderate to Difficult, Time Consuming, Moderate Accuracy Possible.











- **Question Types:** The passage will be focussed on topics like Banking & Economy, Business, Social Issues etc. Fact and Inference based questions, Vocab & Theme based questions.
- Tips: Tips for Economics & Banking based passages, Tips for Style & Tone of RC
- Quizzes: Quiz 1, Quiz 2

(2) Error Spotting & Phrase Replacement

- Weightage: 7-10 Qs
- Moderate in Difficulty, Less to Moderately Time Consuming, Moderate Accuracy Possible.
- **Question Types:** Error Spotting with one or more than one part of the sentence containing the error, 5 sentences will be given & you have to find out the grammatically incorrect/correct sentence among them, Phrase Replacement/ Sentence Correction with more than one correct answers.
- **Topics Covered:** Tenses, Articles, Prepositions, Subject Verb Agreement, Parallelism, Degrees of Comparison, Sentence Construction, Phrasal Verbs, Pronouns, Adverbs, Non-Finite Verbs, Common Errors etc.
- **Tips:** 26 Tips for Error Spotting, Easy Tips for Grammar, General Tips on Tenses, Using Common & Proper Nouns correctly with Articles, Common Errors Made in Degrees of Comparison, Gerunds.

(3) Cloze Test

- Weightage: 0-5 Qs
- **Question Types:** Four words will be given and you need to determine which two words have either synonyms or antonyms relation between them. Your knowledge of vocabulary is tested.

(1) Financial/Banking Awareness

- Weightage: 13-15 Qs
- **Question Types:** Banking and Economy related facts like budget, railway budget, economic survey, etc.; Roles and functions of institutions like RBI, NABARD, SIDBI, etc.; Currencies of various countries; International Trade, Acquisitions and Deals; New Policies and Pacts; Trade Deficits, Exchange Rate, GDP growth, etc. of various countries; Banking related facts.
- **Study Material:** Banks and Headquarters, GDP Growth Rate, How to prepare Financial Awareness for PO Exam.









• Weightage: 7-10 Qs

(2) Current Affairs
